Now that I have completed my nursing degree, I hope to specialize in Pediatric Nursing by completing a residency in Child Nursing at Brandt University.

My nursing experience thus far has taught me that compassion and care truly can push people beyond what they thought they were capable of. During my emergency rotations, I worked on a team of five nurses to provide around-the-clock care for a small county hospital. The work was exhausting, and the later it got, the more severe the cases. However, we were all determined to save as many lives as we could, and regardless of how few hours of sleep we had gotten the night before, the thought of possibly helping someone live pushed us onward. It is that feeling I hope to continue capturing throughout my residency, and I believe that the skills and knowledge I gained during my nursing education will serve me well during my residency in child nursing.

I am applying to Brandt University's Child Nursing program because it is one of the few programs in the country that emphasize caring for children with special needs. These children express different patterns of behavior and thought that other children, and I believe it is important for nurses to gain experience working with these populations and in some cases, educate parents and the community about their condition. I am not only a nurse, I am a mother myself – and on my part. I want to provide the kind of care to my patients that I would provide to my own children.
