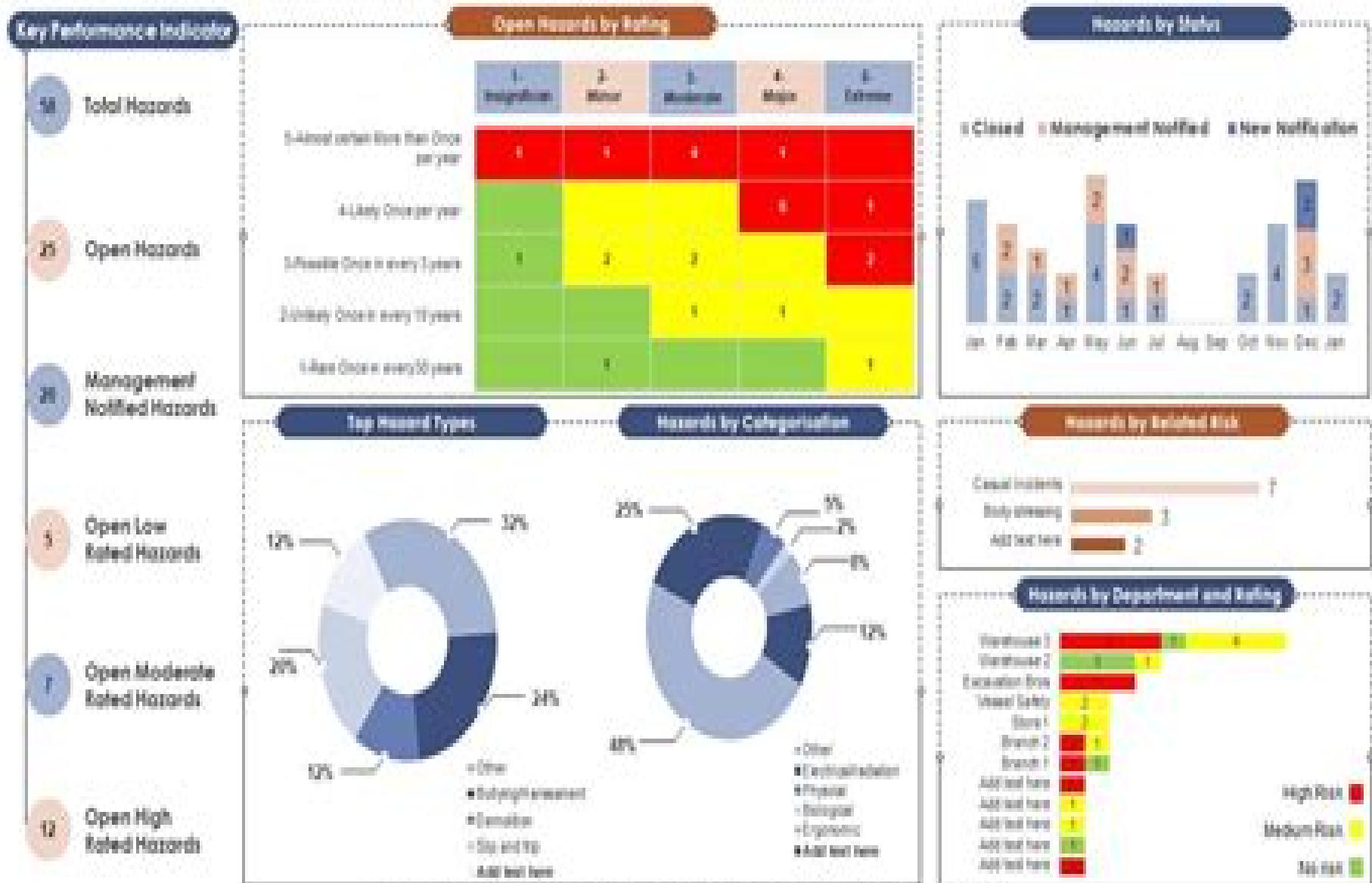


Safety Key Performance Indicator Dashboard with Hazard Ratings
