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Asian City Crossings Rossella Ferrari, Ashley Thorpe, 2021-05-17 *Asian City Crossings* is the first volume to examine the relationship between the city and performance from an Asian perspective This collection introduces city as method as a new conceptual framework for the investigation of practices of city based performing arts collaboration and city to city performance networks across East and Southeast Asia and beyond The shared and yet divergent histories of the global cities of Hong Kong and Singapore as postcolonial multiethnic multicultural and multilingual sites are taken as points of departure to demonstrate how city as method facilitates a comparative analytical space that foregrounds in betweenness and fluid positionalities It situates inter Asian relationality and inter city referencing as centrally significant dynamics in the exploration of the material and ideological conditions of contemporary performance and performance exchange in Asia This study captures creative dialogue that travels city based pathways along the Hong Kong Singapore route as well as between Hong Kong and Singapore and other cities through scholarly analyses and practitioner reflections drawn from the fields of theatre performance and music This book combines essays by scholars of Asian studies theatre studies ethnomusicology and human geography with reflective accounts by Hong Kong and Singapore based performing arts practitioners to highlight the diversity vibrancy and complexity of creative projects that destabilise notions of identity belonging and nationhood through strategies of collaborative conviviality and transnational mobility across multi sited networks of cities in Asia In doing so this volume fills a considerable gap in global scholarly discourse on performance and the city and on the production and circulation of the performing arts in Asia

Theatre and Archival Memory Barry Houlihan, 2021-07-28 This book presents new insights into the production and reception of Irish drama its internationalisation and political influences within a pivotal period of Irish cultural and social change From the 1950s onwards Irish theatre engaged audiences within new theatrical forms at venues from the Pike Theatre the Project Arts Centre and the Gate Theatre as well as at Ireland s national theatre the Abbey Drawing on newly released and digitised archival records this book argues for an inclusive historiography reflective of the formative impacts upon modern Irish theatre as recorded within marginalised performance histories This study examines these works experimental dramaturgical impacts in terms of production reception and archival legacies The book framed by the device of archival memory serves as a means for scholars and theatre makers to inter contextualise existing historiography and to challenge canon formation It also presents a new social history of Irish theatre told from the fringes of history and reanimated through archival memory

Intimate Inequalities Ella Parry-Davies, 2025-09-15 Mobilizing performance to amplify migrant domestic workers creative expertise Intimate inequalities exist where the embodied and the everyday rub up against transnational structures of power Ella Parry Davies conducted collaborative research with migrant domestic workers from the Philippines living in the UK and Lebanon where migration is regulated by employer sponsorship systems to explore how they negotiate the intimacy of the family home and the attendant inequalities of laboring within it

Intimate Inequalities Performing Migrant Domestic Work brings these conditions into focus while articulating a methodological inquiry into the dynamics of collaborative performance research Parry Davies examines site specific soundwalks recorded and coedited with domestic workers which steer the book between church choirs in Beirut and activist gatherings in London and from urban performances in Lebanon's 2019 revolution to mutual aid organizing amid COVID 19 in the UK Breaking with prevalent depictions of migrant domestic workers as voiceless and victimized Intimate Inequalities mobilizes performance as both an analytic lens and a practical methodology amplifying its subjects expertise while reckoning with the intimate yet unequal dynamics of research itself

Occupying the Stage Kate Bredeson, 2018-11-15 Occupying the Stage the Theater of May 68 tells the story of student and worker uprisings in France through the lens of theater history and the story of French theater through the lens of May 68 Based on detailed archival research and original translations close readings of plays and historical documents and a rigorous assessment of avant garde theater history and theory Occupying the Stage proposes that the French theater of 1959-71 forms a standalone paradigm called The Theater of May 68 The book shows how French theater artists during this period used a strategy of occupation occupying buildings streets language words traditions and artistic processes as their central tactic of protest and transformation It further proposes that the Theater of May 68 has left imprints on contemporary artists and activists and that this theater offers a scaffolding on which to build a meaningful analysis of contemporary protest and performance in France North America and beyond At the book's heart is an inquiry into how artists of the period used theater as a way to engage in political work and concurrently questioned and overhauled traditional theater practices so their art would better reflect the way they wanted the world to be Occupying the Stage embraces the utopic vision of May 68 while probing the period's many contradictions It thus affirms the vital role theater can play in the ongoing work of social change

and Continental immigration into England are reinvented and rehearsed on the public stage Kermode uncovers two broad alien stages in the drama distinctive but overlapping processes by which the alien was used to posit ideas and ideals of Englishness Many studies of English national identity pit Englishness against the alien other so that the native self and the alien settle into antithetical positions In contrast Aliens and Englishness reads a body of plays that represent Englishness as a state of ideological invented superiority paradoxically stable in its constant changeability and brought into being by incorporating and eventually accepting and even celebrating rather than rejecting the alien
