--> Terbutaline has effects on receptors. It acts as a sympathomimetic agent stimulating beta 1 receptors which cause tachycardia as a side effect and that is a reason why monitoring maternal and fetal heart rates is most important when terbutaline is being administered. It also affects beta 2 receptors which relaxes the uterus and that is the reason for its administration.
