the rapid fire spread This book gives a firefighter's perspective of the deregulation that caused the tragedy and describes what firefighters were confronted with that June night in 2017 It places that deregulation chronologically alongside a career that spanned three decades including nine years in the training department of the London Fire Brigade It proposes the causes are far deeper and wider than many think A systemic deterioration of standards in testing of materials building control maintenance inspections fire safety and enforcement
