Runes and Roman Letters in Anglo-Saxon Manuscripts Victoria Symons, 2016-10-24 This book presents the first comprehensive study of Anglo Saxon manuscript texts containing runic letters To date there has been no comprehensive study of these works in a single volume although the need for such an examination has long been recognized. This is in spite of a growing academic interest in the mise en page of early medieval manuscripts.
