Tone of witty witicism. Light, sat., conversational
style. Beside the wisdom and fine irony is a ruthless
commentary on the human condition.

Title creates expectation of glorious competition. To
be part of a league suggests competitive status. But
ironically the content of the poem contradicts this.

Sport is absurd, and sad.
Those grown men ~~just~~ look
In those dreary long blue shorts.
Those ringed stockings, Edwardian,
Balding ~~pates~~, and huge
Fat knees that ought to be heroes'

Crown of a man's head – losing hair – manhood.

Official rugby terms used

Grappling, hooking, gallantly ~~licking~~ –
Is all this courage really necessary?
Taking their good clean fun
So solemnly, they run each other down

Sarcasm – words in descending order of importance

Edward (King of England from 1901 – 1910) seems
old fashioned – from a bygone era.

Disgust – sneering – opposite of his idea of the
heroic.

Old fashioned term for valiant / noble in battle –
satirical tone / irony. These men are past it.

Rhetorical question challenges their actions.

Cliche seems ironic – makes fun of them. They are
the cliche.

Poet seems to laugh at the violence but recognises
the sincerity of their objective.

Embarrassment of their dirty bodies in public

Contrast description of youth and middle age –
adults seem unable to recapture their past

Youth – qualities of courage / honour – memories of
a more romantic era

Financial responsibilities – grind of a gulf job

Emotional ties, the weight of a child's dependence,
mundane domesticity

Double meaning / ambiguity – austere life-style /
