- SGOs may be based on appropriate national, state, or LEAdeveloped assessments, including rubric-measured portfolios.
- In 2013-14 teachers with an SGP score will set a minimum of 1 SGO.
- In 2013-14 teachers without an SGP score will set 2 SGOs.
