Jennifer Curtin,Lara Greaves,Jack Vowles,2024-06-25 New Zealand was one of a handful of countries that held a national election in the midst of the Covid 19 pandemic Its policy response stood out as remarkably successful Indeed several years on from the onset of the crisis in 2023 New Zealand still retained a record of no excess deaths While New Zealanders were voting on October 17 2020 their country
