With the introduction of the European currency about 296.8 million citizens of the European Union will hold the new symbols of unity of Europe's peoples in their hands. What began with an attempt of reconciliation and co-operation via the ECSC in 1952 has now developed towards a so far unprecedented transfer of sovereign rights and competence from nation states to a supranational intergovernmental organisation. However, throughout the EU prevail doubts concerning the deeper mechanism of policy making. Despite certain inscrutability and the mysterious nature of decision making, there are demands for more democracy in the Union. On the other side, it may be assumed that most of the European citizens do not really take notice of high and low politics decided upon in the European institutions.
