Force Multiplying Technologies for Logistics Support to Military Operations National Research Council, Division on Engineering and Physical Sciences, Board on Army Science and Technology, Committee on Force Multiplying Technologies for Logistics Support to Military Operations, 2014-12-15 The mission of the United States Army is to fight and win our nation's wars by providing prompt sustained land dominance across the full range of military operations and spectrum of conflict in support of combatant commanders Accomplishing this mission rests on the ability of the Army to equip and move its forces to the battle and sustain them while they are engaged Logistics provides the backbone for Army combat operations Without fuel ammunition rations and other supplies the Army would grind to a halt The U S military must be prepared to fight anywhere on the globe and in an era of coalition warfare to logistically support its allies While aircraft can move large amounts of supplies the vast majority must be carried on ocean going vessels and unloaded at ports that may be at a great distance from the battlefield As the wars in Afghanistan and Iraq have shown the costs of convoying vast quantities of supplies is tallied not only in economic terms but also in terms of lives lost in the movement of the materiel As the ability of potential enemies to interdict movement to the battlefield and interdict movements in the battlespace increases the challenge of logistics grows even larger No matter how the nature of battle develops logistics will remain a key factor Force Multiplying Technologies for Logistics Support to Military Operations explores Army logistics in a global complex environment that includes the increasing use of antiaccess and area denial tactics and technologies by potential adversaries This report describes new technologies and systems that would reduce the demand for logistics and meet the demand at the point of need make maintenance more efficient improve inter and intratheater mobility and improve near real time in transit visibility Force Multiplying Technologies also explores options for the Army to operate with the other services and improve its support of Special Operations Forces This report provides a logistics centric research and development investment strategy and illustrative examples of how improved logistics could look in the future

the Research Council produced the report **Physics Briefs**, 1985 **Breaking Point** Rebecca Schwartz Greene, 2023-01-03 WINNER SOCIETY FOR MILITARY HISTORY DISTINGUISHED BOOK AWARDS FIRST BOOK This book informs the public for the first time about the impact of American psychiatry on soldiers during World War II Breaking Point is the first in depth history of American psychiatry in World War II Drawn from unpublished primary documents oral histories and the author's personal interviews and correspondence over years with key psychiatric and military policymakers it begins with Franklin Roosevelt's endorsement of a universal Selective Service psychiatric examination followed by Army and Navy pre and post induction examinations Ultimately 2.5 million men and women were rejected or discharged from military service on neuropsychiatric grounds Never before or since has the United States engaged in such a program In designing Selective Service Medical Circular No 1 psychiatrist Harry Stack Sullivan assumed psychiatrists could predict who might break down or falter in military service or even in civilian life thereafter While many American and European psychiatrists questioned this belief and huge numbers of American psychiatric casualties soon raised questions about screening's validity psychiatric and military leaders persisted in 1942 and 1943 in endorsing ever tougher screening and little else Soon families complained of fathers and teens being drafted instead of being identified as psychiatric 4Fs and Blacks and Native Americans among others complained of bias A frustrated General George S Patton famously slapped two malingering neuropsychiatric patients in Sicily a sentiment shared by Marshall and Eisenhower though they favored a tamer style Yet psychiatric rejections evacuations and discharges mounted While psychiatrist Roy Grinker and a few others treated soldiers close to the front in Tunisia in early 1943 this was the exception But as demand for manpower soared and psychiatrists finally went to the field and saw that combat itself not predisposition precipitated breakdown leading military psychiatrists switched their emphasis from screening to prevention and treatment But this switch was too little too late and slowed by a year long series of Inspector General investigations even while numbers of psychiatric casualties soared Ironically despite and even partly because of psychiatrists wartime performance plus the emotional toll of war postwar America soon witnessed a dramatic growth in numbers popularity and influence of the profession culminating in the National Mental Health Act 1946 But veterans with PTSD not recognized until 1980 were largely neglected **Sport and Exercise Psychology** Julia Schüler, Mirko Wegner, Henning Plessner, Robert C. **One Nation Under Gold** James Ledbetter,2017-06-13 One Nation Under Gold examines the countervailing forces that have long since divided America whether gold should be a repository of hope or a damaging delusion that has long since derailed the rational investor Worshipped by Tea Party politicians but loathed by sane economists gold has historically influenced American monetary policy and has exerted an often outsized influence on the national psyche for centuries Now acclaimed business writer James Ledbetter explores the tumultuous history and larger than life personalities from George Washington to Richard Nixon behind America s volatile relationship to this hallowed metal and investigates what this enduring obsession reveals about the American identity Exhaustively researched and expertly woven One Nation Under Gold begins with the nation s founding in the 1770s when the new republic erupted with bitter debates over the implementation of paper currency in lieu of metal coins Concerned that the colonies thirteen separate currencies would only lead to confusion and chaos some Founding Fathers believed that a national currency would not only unify the fledgling nation but provide a perfect solution for a country that was believed to be lacking in natural silver and gold resources Animating the Wild West economy of the nineteenth century with searing insights Ledbetter brings to vivid life the actions of Whig president Andrew Jackson one of gold s most passionate advocates whose vehement protest against a standardized national currency would precipitate the nation s first feverish gold rush Even after the establishment of a national paper currency the virulent political divisions continued reaching unprecedented heights at the Democratic National Convention in 1896 when presidential aspirant William Jennings Bryan delivered the legendary Cross of Gold speech that electrified an entire convention floor stoking the fears of his agrarian supporters While Bryan never amassed a wide enough constituency to propel his cause into the White House America s stubborn attachment to gold persisted wreaking so much havoc that FDR in order to help rescue the moribund Depression economy ordered a ban on private ownership of gold in 1933 In fact so entrenched was the belief that gold should uphold the almighty dollar it was not until 1973 that Richard Nixon ordered that the dollar be delinked from any relation to gold completely overhauling international economic policy and cementing the dollar s global significance More intriguing is the fact that America s exuberant fascination with gold has continued long after Nixon s historic decree as in the profusion of late night television ads that appeal to goldbug speculators that proliferate even into the present One Nation Under Gold reveals as much about American economic history as it does about the sectional divisions that continue to cleave our nation ultimately becoming a unique history about economic irrationality and its influence on the American psyche

A Perilous Progress Michael Alan Bernstein,2014-08-12 The

economics profession in twentieth century America began as a humble quest to understand the wealth of nations. It grew into a profession of immense public prestige and now suffers a strangely withered public purpose.
