MADRID, Saturday. — A man was killed, several seriously injured and two children were accidentally shot dead in clashes between rival organizations at Malaga yesterday. The death toll for the past four days is 12 persons.

The situation which has arisen in consequence of the general strike and the conflict between Socialists and Communists, is becoming hourly more serious. The chief of the Municipal Police was recently fired on while walking through the streets.

Clashes are collecting visitors on the outskirts of Malaga. Police in armoured cars have been conveying the mails to Gibraltar. Reinforcements of the Civil Guard and police have arrived at Algeciras from Cadix owing to the fear of disturbances during the annual fair this Sunday.

JERUSALEM, Saturday. — Eighteen Jewish passengers were injured, three of them seriously, when a bomb exploded in a third-class coach on the Haila-Lydda train yesterday morning just as the train was pulling out of Haila station. The train stopped immediately. Nine of the wounded persons, including four women and a child of six, are still in hospital.

The outrage occurred at about 10.30. There was a rush for the exits when the missile was seen, with its fuse burning, rolling down the floor between the seats. One passenger jumped through a window and received cuts and abrasions.

## NEW DEFENCE REGULATIONS

### Grim Powers For Civil Courts

Further regulations to deal with lawlessness have been started under or amended in connection with the Palestine (Defence) Order-in-Council 1933 emergency regulations and published in a Gazette Extraordinary dated June 12.

Under the new enactment, civil courts are empowered to inflict the death penalty on life imprisonment on persons convicted of being in possession of the sword, dir or Turkish dagger, and the Palestine Police Force, the Harvington, or other explosives, interference with the working of harbours, railways, waterways, power stations, transmission lines, or water supply systems, and for doing, by or in concert with any telephone, or telephone line, or apparatus or wireless installation, or any other person, any act which
