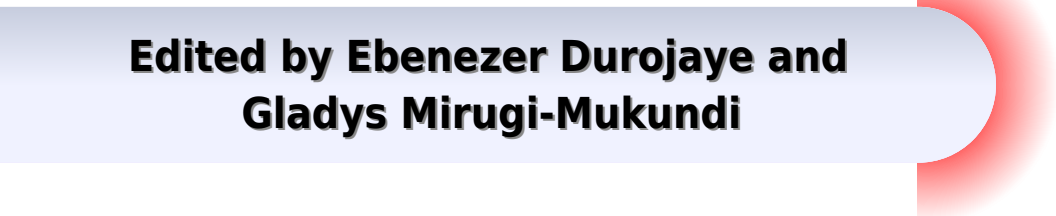

Sa 2015 2016 Budget Speech:

Fees Must Fall Susan Booysen, 2016-10-01 This book explores the student discontent a year after the start of the 2015 South African FeesMustFall revolt. FeesMustFall the student revolt that began in October 2015 was an uprising against lack of access to and financial exclusion from higher education in South Africa. More broadly it radically questioned the socio-political dispensation resulting from the 1994 social pact between big business, the ruling elite and the liberation movement. The 2015 revolt links to national and international youth struggles of the recent past and is informed by black consciousness politics and social movements of the international left. Yet its objectives are more complex than those of earlier struggles. The student movement has challenged the hierarchical top down leadership system of university management and its double speak of professing to act in workers and students interests yet entrenching a regressive system for control and governance. University managements while on one level amenable to change have also co-opted students into their ranks to create co-responsibility for the highly bureaucratised university financial aid that stands in the way of their social revolution. This book maps the contours of student discontent a year after the start of the FeesMustFall revolt. Student voices dissect colonialism, improper compromises by the founders of democratic South Africa, feminism, worker rights and meaningful education. In depth assessments by prominent scholars reflect on the complexities of student activism, its impact on national and university governance and offer provocative analyses of the power of the revolt.

The Political Economy of Mental Illness in South Africa André J van Rensburg, 2021-02-17 The book describes key socio-political reforms that helped shape post-apartheid South Africa's mental health system. The author interrogates how reforms shaped public community based services for people living with severe mental illness and how features of this care have been determined in part at least by the relations between actors and structures in the state-private-for-profit health care and civil society spheres. A description of the development of South Africa's post-apartheid health system and the contentions that emerge therein sets the stage for an analysis of the country's most tragic human rights failure during its democratic period, namely the Life Esidimeni tragedy. The roots of the tragedy are not only framed as a loss of life and dignity as a result of political corruption and administrative mismanagement but as a power differential that ultimately highlights an unjust system that relegates its most vulnerable citizens to commodities without voice and without agency. The book concludes that the commodification of severe mental illness has been a product of neoliberal discourses that have shaped the economic ways in which the post-apartheid South African state have governed poverty and severe mental illness. This book will be of interest to scholars of health, social and economic policy in South Africa.

Acid Mine Drainage in South Africa Suvania Naidoo, 2016-10-13 This SpringerBrief focuses on Acid Mine Drainage (AMD) in the three basins in the Witwatersrand South Africa. It provides a background to AMD and its impacts from a social science perspective. The South African government and non-governmental organizations' response to AMD is assessed as well as the socio-economic and developmental effects of AMD. This volume, which is based on the

author's Master's dissertation at UNISA involves interviews with a range of experts in the field from government departments environmental organisations activists the private sector mining tourism sector and the agricultural sector The book discusses existing policy documents on AMD and provides recommendations in response to the many socio economic impacts which have not been fully addressed A literature review on the global context of AMD is provided South Africa's water systems are already severely harmed by climate change different forms of pollution and poorly managed sanitation systems For these reasons the country is becoming increasingly water stressed and therefore water will continue to become much scarcer in the future As a result of AMD's continued impact on South Africa's water systems as a technical or scientific matter as well as the policy implications for the mining sector water security and socio economic sustainability has become a highly contested issue

Security, Governance, and State Fragility in South Africa Edward L. Mienie, 2020-03-06 Do existing measures of state fragility measure fragility accurately Based on commonly used fragility measures South Africa SA is classified as a relatively stable state yet rising violent crime high unemployment endemic poverty eroding public trust identity group based preferential treatment policies and the rapid rise of the private security sector are all indications that SA may be suffering from latent state fragility Based on a comprehensive view of security this study examines the extent to which measures of political legitimacy and good governance effectiveness in the security system especially with respect to the police system and mounting economic challenges may be undermining the stability of SA in ways undetected by commonly used measures of state fragility Using a mixed methods approach based on quantitative secondary data analysis and semi structured interviews with government officials security practitioners and leading experts in the field this study finds that the combination of colonization apartheid liberation struggle transition from autocracy to democracy high levels of direct and structural violence stagnating social political and economic developments make South Africa a latently fragile state Conceptually the results of this research call into question the validity of commonly used measures of state fragility and suggest the need for a more comprehensive approach to assessing state fragility Practically this study offers a number of concrete policy recommendations for how South Africa may address mounting levels of latent state fragility

Mixed Fortunes Paul Tilley, 2024-03-12 Australia's history is sprinkled with attempts at tax reform some successful some not *Mixed Fortunes* explores these efforts at substantive change in our tax system Paul Tilley takes us from the establishment of the Australian Constitution at Federation in 1901 and the 1942 unification of income tax through the seminal Asprey review in 1975 that set up the major tax reforms of the 1980s and 1990s and up to the lack of tax reform at both the Commonwealth and state levels this century *Mixed Fortunes* examines the roles of foundational reviews which establish the case for reform and determinative reviews which implement reform It assesses both the political economy issues of policymaking and the quality of the tax reforms that have been achieved in Australia The key questions it addresses include What makes a reform exercise work or not How do we assess the quality of Australia's tax reforms And what lessons can be drawn from these

experiences to help shape future tax reform exercises

Thapa, 2020-10-01 Living longer is regarded as a triumph of human development Progress in health services has brought noticeable increase in life expectancy and a reduction in mortality and fertility rate In general wrinkled faces and sags weak bones and changes in appearances manifest old age In Nepal by and large old age has been understood largely from the physical dimension thus there is wider belief that in old age people are frail and weak The main purpose of this research is to explore perceptions and practices on old age To explore this I have employed an interpretative research paradigm and qualitative approach with purposive sampling method The major findings of the study show that security concerns of old age have yet to get adequate attention from family members society and government The elderly people have mixed opinions on their age few consider that old age has brought lots of knowledge experience and skills so they are resourceful whereas others assert themselves as utterly dependent on family and helpless Interestingly it also reveals that longevity has provided an opportunity to ponder upon life and death and they tend to chase more spiritual gatherings and functions This study also reveals the mounting generational gaps emerging in the families
