The State of Secularism Dhammamegha Annie Leatt,2017-09-01 A history of global political secularism comparing religion and traditional authority in apartheid South Africa The Dutch Reformed Church it was said in apartheid South Africa was the National Party at prayer and indeed given that the Bible was so fundamental to much of the legislation that governed the apartheid state that apparently satirical description had the ring of truth Religion in South Africa s past writes Dhammamegha Annie Leatt has been saturated by politics and politics saturated by religion So how she asks was it possible for a new state to found itself without religious authority Why did the churches give up so much of their political role in the transition How can we think about tradition and the customary in relation to secularism How can we not In *The State of Secularism* Leatt guides the reader from a history of global political secularism through an exploration of the roles played by religion and traditional authority in apartheid South Africa to the position of religion in the post apartheid state She analyses the negotiations relating to religion in the constitution making process arguing that South Africa is both secular in its Constitution and judicial foundations and increasingly non secular in its embrace of traditional authorities and customary law In the final chapter Leatt turns her attention to post apartheid South Africa examining changing relationships between churches and the ruling African National Congress and the increasing influence of traditional leaders and evangelical Christians in an anti liberal alliance This book makes a tremendous contribution to the literature on postcolonial politics on the African continent It has wonderful insights into the founding of a constitutional democracy in South African and will appeal to students in history politics sociology and anthropology and constitutional law

Doctoral Education in South Africa Nico Cloete, Johann Mouton, 2015-12-08 Worldwide in Africa and in South Africa the importance of the doctorate has increased disproportionately in relation to its share of the overall graduate output over the past decade This heightened attention has not only been concerned with the traditional role of the PhD namely the provision of future academics rather it has focused on the increasingly important role that higher education and particularly high level skills is perceived to play in national development and the knowledge economy This book is unique in the area of research into doctoral studies because it draws on a large number of studies conducted by the Centre of Higher Education Trust CHET and the Centre for Research on Evaluation Science and Technology CREST as well as on studies from the rest of Africa and the world In addition to the

Mienie,2020-03-06 Do existing measures of state fragility measure fragility accurately Based on commonly used fragility measures South Africa SA is classified as a relatively stable state yet rising violent crime high unemployment endemic poverty eroding public trust identity group based preferential treatment policies and the rapid rise of the private security sector are all indications that SA may be suffering from latent state fragility Based on a comprehensive view of security this study examines the extent to which measures of political legitimacy and good governance effectiveness in the security system especially with respect to the police system and mounting economic challenges may be undermining the stability of SA in ways undetected by commonly used measures of state fragility Using a mixed methods approach based on quantitative secondary data analysis and semi structured interviews with government officials security practitioners and leading experts in the field this study finds that the combination of colonization apartheid liberation struggle transition from autocracy to democracy high levels of direct and structural violence stagnating social political and economic developments make South Africa a latently fragile state Conceptually the results of this research call into question the validity of commonly used measures of state fragility and suggest the need for a more comprehensive approach to assessing state fragility Practically this study offers a number of concrete policy recommendations for how South Africa may address mounting levels of latent state fragility Youth In South Africa Ariane De Lannoy,Malose Langa,2021-05-05 South Africa is characterised by a
