Wound Dressing Guidelines

1. Decide what sort of wound you are treating:

Diabetic slove: Open sore that often occurs on the plantar espect of fact. Often starts as a blister. Most often in patients with decreased semeston. Priorities: OFFLOADING

Veneza store: Irregular shaped and painful ulter on lower extremities and ankles. Utsually accompany hemosiderin staining and edema. Drain moderate to large amounts. Prioritize: COMPRESSION

Attenual silicen Ringular shaped, punched out appearance, and painful. Usually on lower legs, top of feet, or toes. Less dearning and bleeding than other usors. Prioritise: ASI AND WISCUILAR CONSULT.

2. Decide how deep the wound is:

Partial thickness: Extends into the opidermis and decrais.

Full thickness: Extends through the dermis into subcutaneous or beyond into muscle, bone or tendon-

3. Follow the instructions and care guidance chart below:

- Please take photos of all wounds before referral to Wound Care.
- Chronic wounds: Order ABIs for all significant chronic wounds (> 3 weeks duration) if not done in last 6 months.
- Venous disease: With evidence of venous disease, encourage compression and elevation using Compriler bendage stocking, Tubigrip, or electic bendage).
- Diabetic wounds: Take pressure off plantar diabetic wounds with appropriete fluctures if available. If not, try to keep non-weight bearing.
- All dressings should be changed at least once a day. Wet-to-dry dressings should be changed twice a day. If there is no improvement in one week, refer to the Wound Clinic. If you have questions, contact Linnea Briggs, ARNP or Nichole Shoemaker, RN via Epic or Voets.
