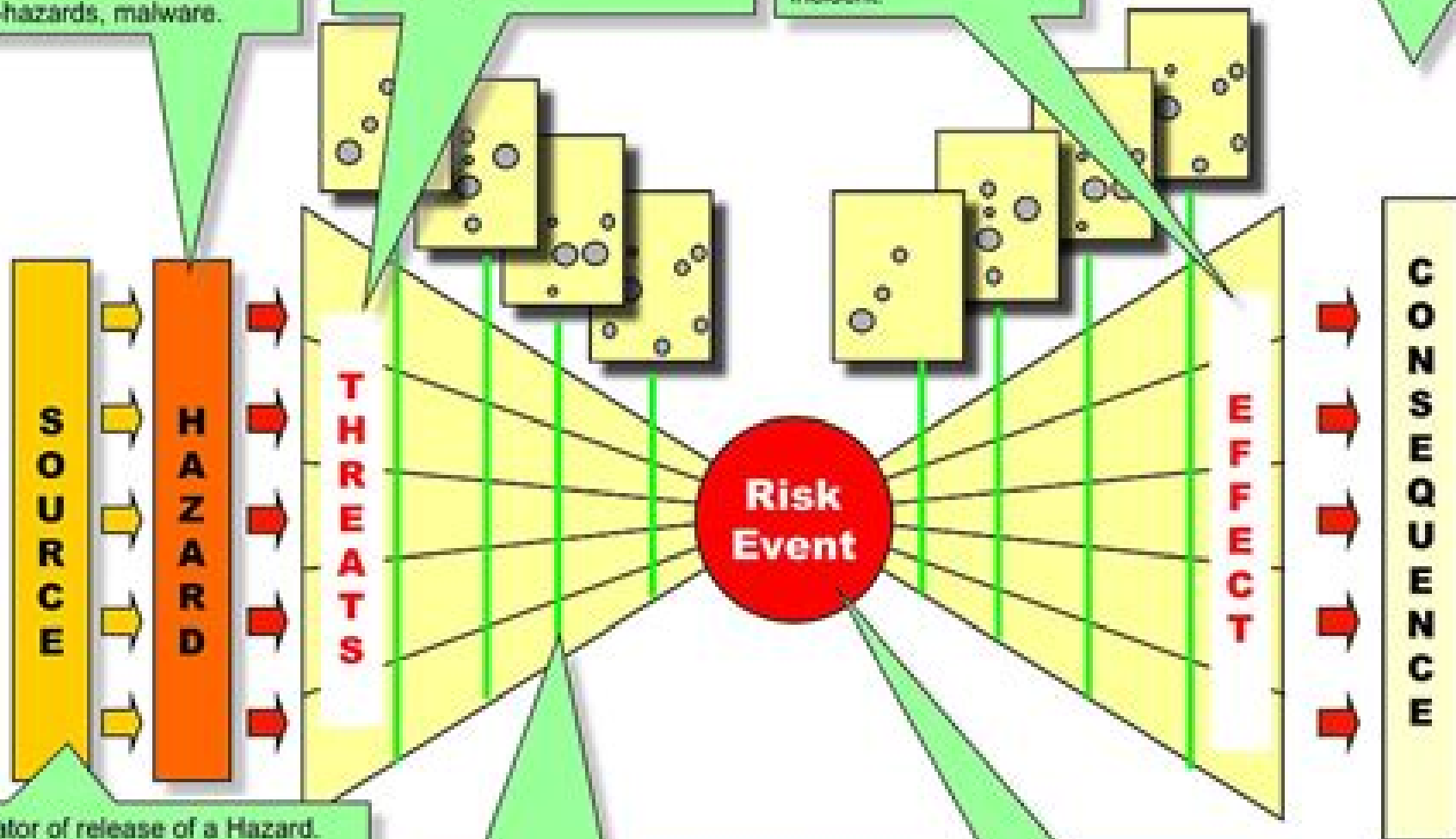


Anything with potential to adversely impact objectives when released or applied against an asset. Eg: Flammable substances, explosives, bio-hazards, malware.

Collective sum of all impacts. Includes long term & indirect combined health, economic, and psychological impacts.



Controls (Deterrent, Preventative, Corrective & Detective). Includes Controls (existing) and Treatments (proposed).
