Over the decades he developed a practice of attention that was endlessly curious and enthralled by the living world what he calls its pattern or syntax Despite acclaim as a celebrated writer throughout his career Lopez humbly tasked himself with making a combination of wonder and horror work together to effectively communicate a life journey of contemplation exploration and discovery
