Before Identity Richard F. Calichman, 2021-02-01 Before Identity represents the first attempt to provide a comprehensive examination of the methodological ground of Japan studies At its most basic level the field presupposes the immediate empirical existence of an entity known as the Japanese people or Japanese culture from which it then carves out its various objects of inquiry Richard F Calichman attempts to show that this presupposition is itself ineluctably bound up with modern forms of knowledge formation thereby enlarging the scope of what is meant by modernity In this way he aims to bring about a heightened level of theoretical critical vigilance in the field Calichman explores the methodological commitments implied or expressed in the work of a range of writers and scholars Murakami Haruki Komori Y ichi Harry Harootunian Tomi Suzuki Alan Tansman and Dennis Washburn and how such commitments have shaped and limited the field If theoretical issues in Japan studies are not subjected to this sort of in depth scrutiny Calichman argues then the field will continue to remain ghettoized relative to other disciplines in the humanities and social sciences which have typically been more receptive to conceptual discourse By showing that scholarly inquiry must begin not at the level of the object but rather at the more fundamental level of methodology Calichman aims to introduce a greater degree of theoretical rigor to the discipline of Japan studies as a whole

Race and Revolution Gary B.
