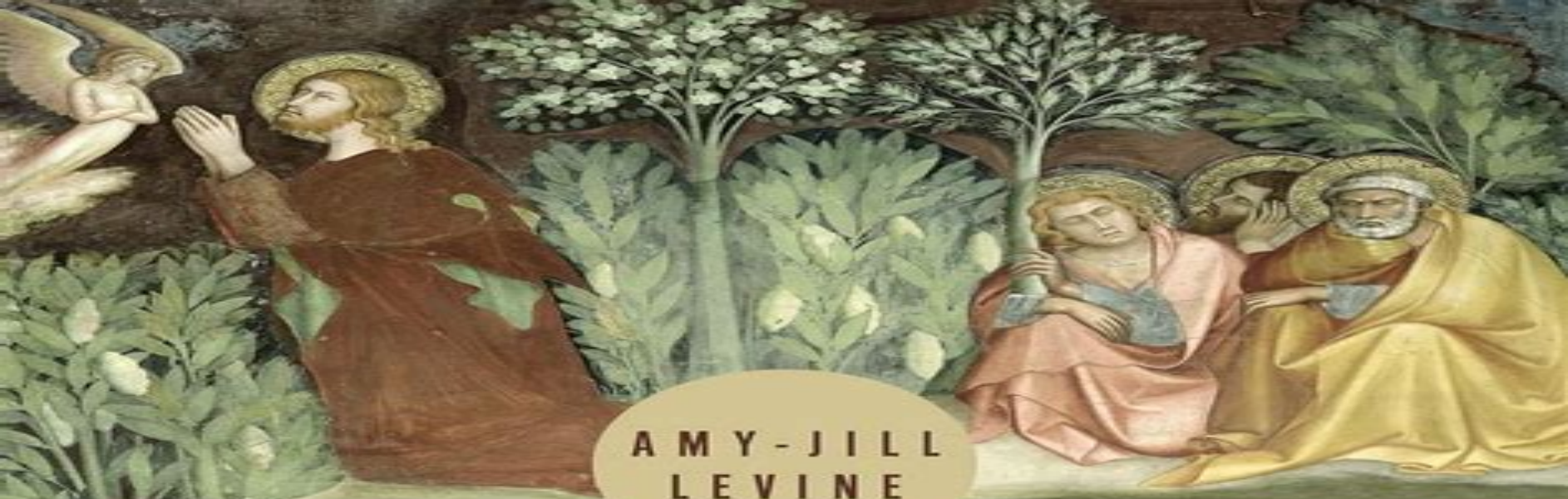

Postcolonial Reading of Mark's Story of Jesus Simon Samuel, 2007-04-18 This unique contribution to Markan studies reads Mark's story of Jesus from a postcolonial perspective. It proposes that Mark need not necessarily be treated in an oversimplified polarity as an anti or pro colonial discourse. Instead it may be treated as a postcolonial discourse, i.e. as a hybrid discourse that accommodates and disrupts both the native Jewish and the Roman colonial discourses of power. It shows that Mark accommodates itself into a strategic third space in between the variegated native Jewish and the Roman colonial discourses in order to enunciate its own voice. As an ambivalent and hybrid discourse it mimics and mocks, accommodates and disrupts both the Jewish as well as the Roman colonial voices. The portrait of Jesus in Mark, which Samuel shows to be encoding also the portrait of a community, exhibits a colonial/postcolonial conundrum which can neither be damned as pro nor be praised as anti colonial in nature. Instead the portrait of Jesus in Mark may be appreciated as a strategic essentialist and transcultural hybrid in which the claims of difference and the desire for transculturality are both contradictorily present and visible. In showing such a portrait and invoking a complex discursive strategy, Mark as the discourse of a subject community is not alone or unique in the Graeco-Roman world. A number of discourses, historical

creative novelistic and apocalyptic of the subject Greek and Jewish communities in the eastern Mediterranean under the imperium of Rome from the second century BCE to the end of the first century CE exhibit very similar postcolonial traits which one may add to be not far from the postcolonial traits of a number of postcolonial creative writings and cultural discourses of the colonial subject and the dominated post colonial communities of our time

Reading Mark's Gospel as a Text from Collective Memory Sandra Huebenthal,2020-05-28 How did the Gospel of Mark come to exist And how was the memory of Jesus shaped by the experiences of the earliest Christians For centuries biblical scholars examined texts as history literature theology or even as story Curiously absent however has been attention to processes of collective memory in the creation of biblical texts Drawing on modern explorations of social memory Sandra Huebenthal presents a model for reading biblical texts as collective memories She demonstrates that the Gospel of Mark is a text evolving from collective narrative memory based on recollections of Jesus s life and teachings Huebenthal investigates the principles and structures of how groups remember and how their memory is structured and presented In the case of Mark s Gospel this includes examining which image of Jesus as well as which authorial self image this text as memory constructs Reading Mark s Gospel as a Text from Collective Memory serves less as a key to unlock questions about the historical Jesus and more as an examination of memory about him within a particular community providing a new and important framework for interpreting the earliest canonical gospel in context

readers The new paradigm implicit in these initial experiments is based on the recent realization that the majority of persons 85 to 95 percent were illiterate and experienced the Jesus stories as members of audiences Either from memory or from memorized manuscripts the evangelists performed the Gospels as an evening s entertainment of two to four hours The audiences were predominantly addressed as Hellenistic Judeans who lived in the aftermath of the Roman Jewish war When heard whole the Gospels were vivid experiences of the central character of Jesus These studies of audience address and the interactions between first century storytellers and audiences reveal a dynamic performance literature that functioned as scripts for an ever expanding network of storytelling proclamations whose envisioned horizon was the whole world When the Gospels were told at one time from beginning to end they invited the listeners to move from being peripherally interested or initially opposed to Jesus to identifying themselves as disciples of Jesus and believers in him as the Messiah
