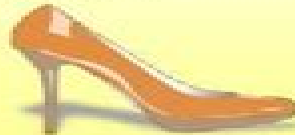

Your wife chooses very beautiful shoes in the shop. You see that they're too expensive. You ask her to choose the other shoes but she doesn't want.



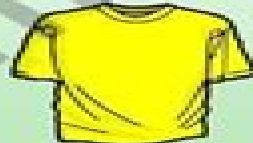
You're shopping with your 5-year-old child. Suddenly he starts whining, yelling loudly and asking to buy him many toys. Try to calm him down.
