Genetics it has been found that both RD and MD are based on genetic factors and run in families Moreover math problem solving shares significant genetic overlap with general cognitive ability and reading decoding whereas math fluency shares significant genetic overlap with reading fluency and general cognitive ability Hence this topic will explore the shared and unique genetic risk factors to RD and MD In addition to shared and unique genetic influence on reading and math

Neural perspective converging evidence from both structural and multiple functional imaging studies involving a wide range of numerical tasks points to the intraparietal sulcus IPS as a core region that involve in quantity manipulation However several additional brain areas such as frontoparietal and temporoparietal areas were found to be involved in numerical tasks

Education it will be interesting to look at the effect of interventions that aim to improve reading such as phonological awareness and there transfer effect on improving mathematical processing

Alternatively it will be good to test whether math interventions will improve reading
