Buschmann,2023-07 *Hoarding New Guinea* provides a new cultural history of colonialism that pays close attention to the millions of Indigenous artifacts that serve as witnesses to Europe s colonial past in ethnographic museums Rainer F Buschmann investigates the roughly two hundred thousand artifacts extracted from the colony of German New Guinea from 1870 to 1920 Reversing the typical trajectories that place ethnographic museums at the center of the analysis he concludes that museum interests in material culture alone cannot account for the large quantities of extracted artifacts Buschmann moves beyond the easy definition of artifacts as trophies of colonial defeat or religious conversion instead employing the term hoarding to describe the irrational amassing of Indigenous artifacts by European colonial residents Buschmann also highlights Indigenous material culture as a bargaining chip for its producers to engage with the imposed colonial regime In addition by centering an area of collection rather than an institution he opens new areas of investigation that include non professional ethnographic collectors and a sustained rather than superficial consideration of Indigenous peoples as producers behind the material culture *Hoarding New Guinea* answers the call for a more significant historical focus on colonial ethnographic collections in European museums **My Hand Will Write what My Heart Dictates** Frances

Nahuatl Nations Magnus Pharao Hansen,2024-08-09 *Nahuatl Nations* is a linguistic ethnography that explores the

political relations between those Indigenous communities of Mexico that speak the Nahuatl language and the Mexican Nation that claims it as an important national symbol Author Magnus Phrao Hansen studies how this relation has been shaped by history and how it plays out today in Indigenous Nahua towns regions and educational institutions and in the Mexican diaspora He argues that Indigenous languages are likely to remain vital as long as they used as languages of political community and they also protect the community s sovereignty by functioning as a barrier that restricts access to the participation for outsiders Semiotic sovereignty therefore becomes a key concept for understanding how Indigenous communities can maintain both their political and linguistic vitality While the Mexican Nation seeks to expropriate Indigenous semiotic resources in order to improve its brand on an international marketplace Indigenous communities may employ them in resistance to state domination *Improving Students' Writing, K-8* Diane M. Jarvis,2012-12-01 In an exploration of the oceanic connections of the Atlantic world Michael J Jarvis recovers a mariner's view of early America as seen through the eyes of Bermuda's seafarers The first social history of eighteenth century Bermuda this book profiles how one especially intensive maritime community capitalized on its position in the eye of all trade Jarvis takes readers aboard small Bermudian sloops and follows white and enslaved sailors as they shuttled cargoes between ports raked salt harvested timber salvaged shipwrecks hunted whales captured prizes and smuggled contraband in an expansive maritime sphere spanning Great Britain's North American and Caribbean colonies In doing so he shows how humble sailors and seafaring slaves operating small family owned vessels were significant but underappreciated agents of Atlantic integration The American Revolution starkly revealed the extent of British America's integration before 1775 as it shattered interregional links that Bermudians had helped to forge Reliant on North America for food and customers Bermudians faced disaster at the conflict's start A bold act of treason enabled islanders to continue trade with their rebellious neighbors and helped them to survive and even prosper in an Atlantic world at war Ultimately however the creation of the United States ended Bermuda's economic independence and doomed the island's maritime economy **Hunting the Gatherers** Michael O'Hanlon,Robert L. The Devil's Lane Catherine Clinton, Michele Gillespie, 1997-06-26 When Europeans settled in the early South they quarreled over many things but few imbroglios were so fierce as battles over land Landowners wrangled bitterly over boundaries with neighbors and contested areas became known as the devil's lane Violence and bloodshed were but some of the consequences to befall those who ventured into these disputed territories The Devil's Lane highlights important new work on sexuality race and gender in the South from the seventeenth to the nineteenth centuries Contributors explore legal history by examining race crime and punishment sex across the color line and slander Emerging stars and established scholars such as Peter Wood and Carol Berkin weave together the fascinating story of competing agendas and clashing cultures on the southern frontier One chapter focuses on a community's resistance to a hermaphrodite where the town court conducted a series of examinations to determine the individual's gender Other pieces address topics ranging from resistance to sexual exploitation on the part of slave women to spousal murders from interpreting women's expressions of religious ecstasy to a pastor's sermons about depraved sinners and graphic depictions of carnage all in the name of exposing evil and from a case of infanticide to the practice of state mandated castration Several of the authors pay close attention to the social and personal dynamics of interracial women's networks and relationships across place and time The Devil's Lane illuminates early forms of sexual oppression inviting comparative questions about authority and violence social attitudes and sexual tensions the impact of slavery as well as the twisted course of race relations among blacks whites and Indians Several scholars look particularly at the Gulf South myopically neglected in traditional literature and an outstanding feature of this collection These eighteen original essays reveal why the intersection of sex and race marks an essential point of departure for understanding southern social relations and a turning point for the field of colonial history

The Making of New World Slavery Robin Blackburn, 1997 At the time when European powers colonized the Americas the institution of slavery had almost disappeared from Europe itself Having overcome an institution widely regarded as oppressive why did they sponsor the construction of racial slavery in their new colonies Robin Blackburn traces European doctrines of race and slavery from medieval times to the early modern epoch and finds that the stigmatization of the ethno religious Other was given a callous twist by a new culture of consumption freed from an earlier moral economy

The Making of New World Slavery argues that independent commerce geared to burgeoning consumer markets was the driving force behind the rise of plantation slavery The baroque state sought successfully to batten on this commerce and unsuccessfully to regulate slavery and race Successive chapters of the book consider the deployment of slaves in the colonial possessions of the Portuguese the Spanish the Dutch the English and the French Each are shown to have contributed something to the eventual consolidation of racial slavery and to the plantation revolution of the seventeenth and eighteenth centuries It is shown that plantation slavery emerged from the impulses of civil society rather than from the strategies of the individual states Robin Blackburn argues that the organization of slave plantations placed the West on a destructive path to modernity and that greatly preferable alternatives were both proposed and rejected Finally he shows that the surge of Atlantic trade premised on the killing toil of the plantations made a decisive contribution to both the Industrial Revolution and the rise of the West
