eliminate any threat to the young French Republic Robespierre envisioned a Republic of Virtue with no room for anyone who did not abide by his rules and morality Counterrevolutionaries certainly did threaten the Revolution however most of those killed during the Reign of Terror were not counterrevolutionaries and posed no serious threat to the Revolution or Republic
