A Sourcebook for Ancient Greek John Tomarchio, 2022-09-09 This book was designed for students transitioning from the study of Greek grammar to translation of texts It was developed in classroom use for classroom use in the context of an integrated Great Books program in liberal arts and sciences It is meant for students not only of Classics but more for students of Humanities interested in direct engagement of primary sources Each Greek text offered for translation was chosen for its theoretical interest as well as the interest of its Greek The selections of Greek literature offered in this Sourcebook are wide ranging The indisputable standard of excellence for classicists is of course the Attic dialect of Athens in its glory However this Sourcebook is meant for students of liberal arts and sciences whose interests range far more widely Thus it does not hesitate to extend not only backward to the archaic Greek of Homer but also forward to the koine Greek of

the Alexandrian and Roman empires Greek works were chosen for being seminal to Western thinking today chosen to give students of Western arts and sciences introductions to its Greek sources Naturally Greek grammar is taught to the newcomer analytically and sequentially but the continuing student needs to synthesize these distended enumerations of elements and principles Accordingly grammatical synopses are not appended as reference tables but placed front and center as objects of study The grammar tables offer synoptic views of integral parts of Greek grammar to show the form and logic of the whole part of speech or part of a sentence On the basis of these tables detailed grammatical notes and commentary appended to Greek selections that follow are tailored for continuing students

A Gorgon's Mask Lewis A. Lawson, 2005 The thesis of *A Gorgon's mask* The Mother in Thomas Mann's Fiction depends upon three psychoanalytic concepts Freud's early work on the relationship between the infant and its mother and on the psychology of artistic creation Annie Reich's analysis of the grotesque comic sublimation and Edmund Bergler's analysis of writer's block Mann's crisis of sexual anxiety in late adolescence is presented as the defining moment for his entire artistic life In the throes of that crisis he included a sketch of a female as Gorgon in a book that would not escape his mother's notice But to defend himself from being overcome by the Gorgon mother's stare he employed the grotesque comic sublimation hiding the mother figure behind fictional characters physically attractive but psychologically repellent all the while couching his fiction in an ironic tone that evoked humor however lacking in humor the subtext might be In this manner he could deny to himself that the mother figure always lurked in his work and by that denial deny that he was a victim of oral regression For as Edmund Bergler argues the creative writer who acknowledges his oral dependency will inevitably succumb to writer's block Mann's late work reveals that his defense against the Gorgon is crumbling In Doctor Faustus Mann portrays Adrian Leverkühn as ultimately the victim of oral regression but the fact that Mann was able to compete the novel despite severe physical illness and psychological distress demonstrates that he himself was still holding writer's block at bay In *Confessions of Felix Krull Confidence Man* a narrative that he had abandoned forty years before Mann was finally forced to acknowledge that he was depleted of creative vitality but not of his capacity for irony brilliantly couching the victorious return of the repressed in ambiguity This study will be of interest to general readers who enjoy Mann's narrative art to students of Mann's work especially its psychological and mythological aspects and to students of the psychology of artistic creativity

Transfiguring Tragedy Ryder Thornton, 2024-07-19 This book demonstrates Eugene O'Neill's use of philosophy in the early period of his work and provides analyses of selected works from that era concluding with *The Hairy Ape* completed in 1921 as an illustration of the mastery he had achieved in dramatizing key concepts of philosophy Analyses of one act and full length plays from 1913 to 1921 reveal the influence of the three philosophers and establish that O'Neill was fundamentally a philosophic playwright even from his earliest dramatic sketches Specific concepts from Schopenhauer Stirner and Nietzsche went into O'Neill's shaping of character arcs dramatic circumstances symbology and theme Among them are Schopenhauer's concept of will and

representation Stirner's notion of possession and Nietzsche's principle of the Apollonian Dionysian duality. These ideas were foundational to O'Neill's construction of tragic irony apparent in his early period plays. The critical concepts of these three philosophers are the major pathways in this study. However, such an approach inevitably reveals other layers of spiritual influence such as Catholicism and Eastern philosophy which are touched on in these analyses. This book is a much needed introduction to philosophic concepts in Eugene O'Neill's early work and would be of great interest to students and scholars in theatre studies and philosophy.

Based on the author's discovery of a new folktale type, the female trickster, Jurich's book identifies and celebrates those female protagonists in folktales who use trickery to save themselves and others, to find new directions for their lives, and to declare their individual autonomies, especially in societies that diminish and oppress women. Through creative strategies depending on verbal facility, psychological acuity, and diplomatic know-how, these women tricksters, better named trickstars, uncover the absurdity, hypocrisy, and corruption in the larger patriarchal society. Through the trickstar's efforts, the system is circumvented or foiled, often enlightened and usually improved. This multicultural comparative study reveals universal human traits as well as gender differences between female and male tricksters and realizes the values and attitudes which shape the trickstar's character and behavior. Trickstars also appear outside of the oral folktale tradition; the author discusses their roles in contemporary feminist revisionist tales as well as in mythology, biblical narratives, Shakespearean comedy, novels, plays, and opera. How the female trickster differs from her male counterpart is for the first time in folklore studies illustrated through a comparison of their functions in the narrative scheme of the tale. These functions include the diverting or amusing role, the morally ambiguous or reprehensible role, the role of the manipulator or strategist, and the role of the transformer or culture bringer who reforms and improves the nature of her society. Jurich delineates the specific types of tricksters who perform these functions, suggests how trickstar tales variously affect listeners and readers, and shows how particular types of trickstar characters contribute to the intent of the tale. Feminist views of the protagonists are analyzed as well as contemporary revisionist tales which seek to reverse negative female images and to present independent women characters who can and do

make positive contributions to society For the first time in folklore studies both female and male tricksters are defined and differentiated their functions are illustrated through analyzing narrative schemes and the term trickstar invented by the author is used to define and describe a female trickster **Mythology for the Microcosm** A. Brian Lasater,2005-12 About my book Although there is nothing new under the sun it is always useful to reevaluate old ideas and principles and express them in new and original ways There are many books on the Kabala but based on what I have seen and read there is room for a comprehensive approach Many authors leave out fundamental principles altogether like the authors who don't even mention the celestial bodies and the Zodiac On the other hand scholars of mythology generally do not even refer to astrology and the Kabala and apparently do not recognise that the celestial bodies were the principle gods of the ancient pantheon My approach has been to briefly discuss some of the fundamental elements of the old theologies and relate them to astrology and the Kabala from a modern perspective Thus I have laid an essential foundation for the Kabala and astrology and placed them in the context of Greek and Roman mythology Since I have adopted a broad perspective the reader has a basis for pursuing these subjects in a variety of ways I have not seen any other book that relates astrology and the Kabala to Greek and Roman mythology the Bible and then relates these to Mesopotamian and Egyptian mythology The ancient theologies have many fundamental elements in common and these form key parts of the foundation of astrology and the Kabala In addition I have given a concise discussion of the Four Alchemical Elements the Signs of the Zodiac and the Celestial Bodies and placed them in a Kabbalistic framework To truly comprehend the Kabala and Astrology it must be remembered that it is one complete whole and it is broken down to make analysis practicable Therefore I have discussed Creation and the Ten Sephiroth the trinity in some of its forms as a sacred elements in Creation and in Man and Woman the Four Elements and the Zodiac Then from a mythological and theological perspective I have looked briefly at Mesopotamia and Egyptian As a counterweight to our cynical age I have looked at the Golden Age of Atlantis and the mythological heroes and heroines of the primordial past serve as exemplars and encourage us to strive to attain some of Occidental Civilization's highest ideals On the other hand Atlantis is a warning the misuse of knowledge and power leads to the destruction of civilization Further from a theological and mythical perspective the Sephiroth were divine instruments used in Creation On a more mundane level the Kabala and astrology are a means to know ourselves and obey the injunction Know Thyself that used to be inscribed on Apollo's temple at Delphi This book is based on the work of the ancients whose writing is superb The quotes in English from the ancients are the best part of the book and it is a pleasure to read **Heroes in Greek Mythology Rock!** Karen Bornemann
