Without this knowledge Romeo would not have attended as a masked man, never seeing Juliet. Whilst if Peter, the messenger, having being able to read, would not have enlisted to help of Romeo. At the believed death of Juliet, his immaturity results in his murder of Paris, whom desires a farewell, Romeo's killing words being, 'wilt thou provoke me? Then have at thee, boy!'
