Harriet Beecher Stowe Joan D. Hedrick,1995-06-01 Up to this year I have always felt that I had no particular call to meddle with this subject But I feel now that the time is come when even a woman or a child who can speak a word for freedom and humanity is bound to speak Thus did Harriet Beecher Stowe announce her decision to begin work on what would become one of the most influential novels ever written The subject she had hesitated to meddle with was slavery and the novel of course was Uncle Tom's Cabin Still debated today for its portrayal of African Americans and its unresolved place in the literary canon Stowe's best known work was first published in weekly installments from June 5 1851 to April 1 1852 It caused such a stir in both the North and South and even in Great Britain that when Stowe met President Lincoln in 1862 he is said to have greeted her with the words So you are the little woman who wrote the book that created this great war In this

associations in the 1990s to install the mayor as head of the school system a governing regime now challenged by privatization advocates Business people may be too wedded to a stunted view of educators to forge a productive partnership for change Unionized teachers bridle at the second class status accorded them by managers If reform is to reach deeply into classrooms Shipps concludes it might well require a new coalition of teachers unions and parents to create a fresh agenda that supersedes corporate interests This study clearly shows that in Chicago as elsewhere urban schooling is intertwined with politics and power By reviewing more than a century of corporate efforts to make education work Shipps makes a strong case that it s high time to look elsewhere perhaps to educators themselves for new leadership **Corpus Juris** William Mack, William Benjamin Hale, 1918
