- C. Know some factors that might affect heart rate. Altered by ANS, response to information received from barroreceptors and chemoreceptors. So oxygen levels, CO2 and PH.
- D. Know the Frank-Starling law. Stroke volume is proportional to end-diastolic volume. The Ventricles will eject as much blood as they receive.
- E. Know some factors that might affect the strength of contractions (and therefore stroke volume). Contractility, or contraction strength, calcium increases strength, epinephrine and norephrine both increase heart rate and the strength of each contraction.
