Kennedy,2017-09-04 Several recent papers underline methodological points that limit the validity of published results in imaging studies in the life sciences and especially the neurosciences Carp 2012 Ingre 2012 Button et al 2013 Ioannidis 2014 At least three main points are identified that lead to biased conclusions in research findings endemic low statistical power and selective outcome and selective analysis reporting Because of this and in view of the lack of replication studies false discoveries or solutions persist To overcome the poor reliability of research findings several actions should be promoted including conducting large cohort studies data sharing and data reanalysis The construction of large scale online databases should be facilitated as they may contribute to the definition of a collective mind Fox et al 2014 facilitating open collaborative work or crowd science Franzoni and Sauermann 2014 Although technology alone cannot change scientists practices Wicherts et al 2011 Wallis et al 2013 Poldrack and Gorgolewski 2014 Roche et al 2014 technical solutions should be identified which support a more open science
