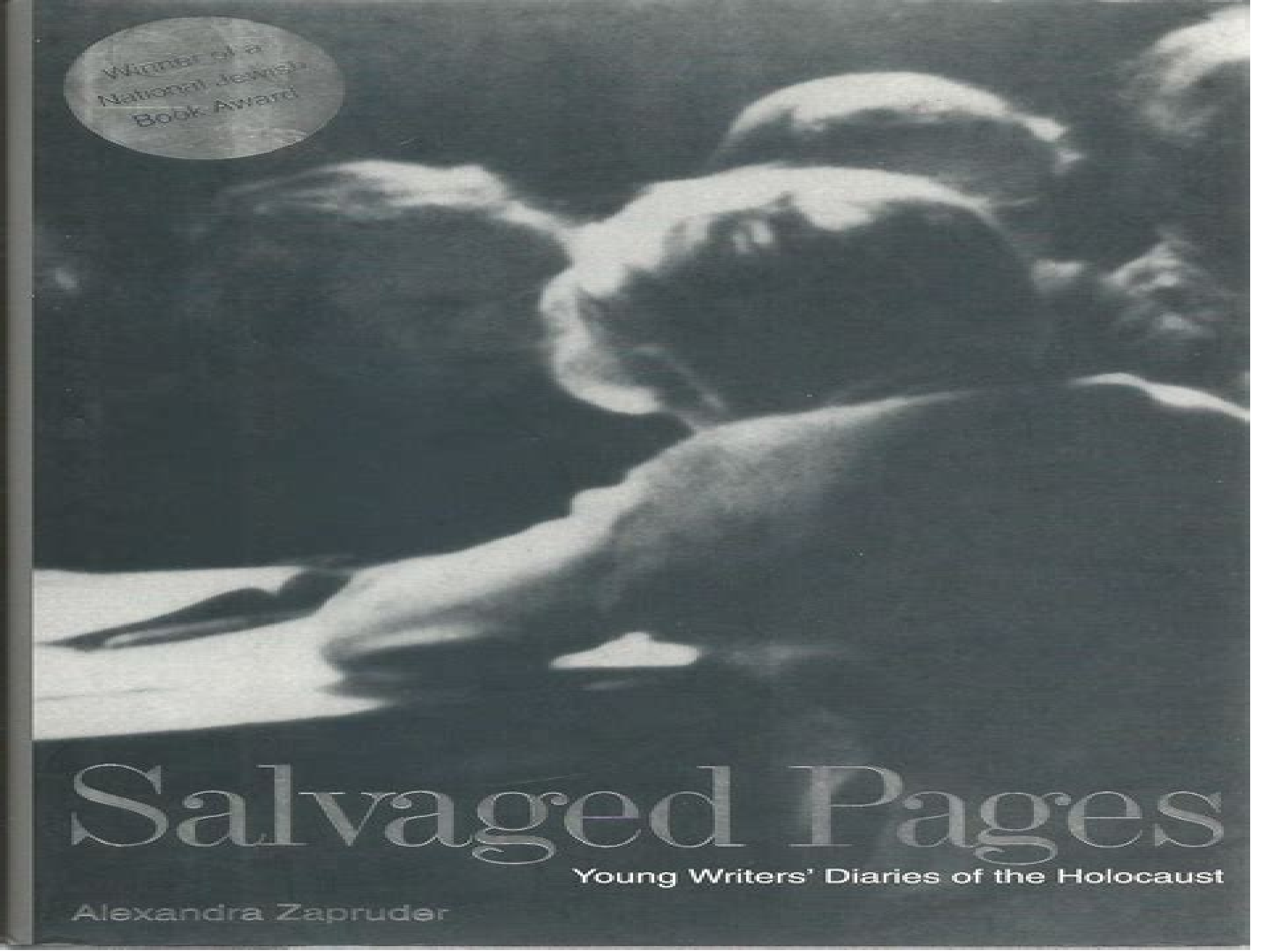

We Who Lived Hava Bromberg Ben-Zvi, 2018-01-12 Hava Eva Bromberg and Ephraim Sokal were Jewish teenagers in Poland when the Nazis invaded in 1939 Hiding in plain sight Bromberg lived among the non Jewish Polish population always in danger of discovery or betrayal Sokal and his family were deported as enemies of the people when the Russians occupied eastern Poland a calamity that saved their lives Liberated by the 1941 Nazi invasion of the Soviet Union Sokal fought the Germans serving with the Polish Navy and British armed forces Bromberg and Sokal met in 1947 both facing the challenges of surviving in a postwar world they were unprepared for This combined memoir tells their story of resilience

Children Writing the Holocaust S. Vice, 2004-06-29 This book examines a wide range of works written by and about child survivors and victims of the Holocaust The writers analyzed range from Anne Frank and Saul Friedlander to Ida Fink and Louis Begley topics covered include the Kindertransport experience exile to Siberia living in hiding Jewish children masquerading as Christian and ghetto diaries Throughout the argument is made that these texts use such similar techniques and structures that children's eye views of the Holocaust constitute a discrete literary genre

murdered in just 18 months and of a campaign of terror exploitation and ultimately ethnic cleansing against the Polish population which was intended to serve as a template for the rest of eastern Europe. This work examines how the early reformers of the 19th century and their legacy into the 20th century created a livable liberal Jewish identity that allowed a reinvention of what it meant to be Jewish, a process that continues today. Many scholars of the modern Jewish identity focus on the ways in which the past two centuries have resulted in the loss of Jewishness through assimilation, intermarriage, conversion to other faiths, genocide in the Holocaust and decline in religious observance.
