and Marie Curie By the 1980s following the discovery of the Salk and Sabin vaccines and the March of Dimes withdrawal from polio research most Americans had forgotten polio its therapies and Sister Kenny In examining this historical arc and the public s process of forgetting Naomi Rogers presents Kenny as someone worth remembering Polio Wars recalls both the passion and the practices of clinical care and explores them in their own terms
