L RED EYE DEFINITION

- Hyperemia or injection of the superficially visible vessels of the conjunctiva, episclera, or sclera
- Can be caused by disorders of the different structures like the cornea, iris, ciliary bodies, and ocular adnexa
- Chief complaint of eye redness can have multiple differential diagnosis based on:
 - History of the patient
 - Physical exam findings



Figure 1. Red eye seen in a patient. Note the hyperemia of the ocular vessels

- II. ACUTE ANGLE CLOSURE GLAUCOMA
- Previously discussed in "Chronic Vision Loss" lecture
- Acute angle closure glaucoma is actually the one causing the eye redness when a patient has AACG
- Presentations:
 - Suggestive of corneal edema are: (figure 2):
 - Irregular corneal reflection
 - Hazy comea
 - Usually the pupil is dilated
 - o Iris in anteriorly displaced
 - Shallowing of the anterior chamber (stigure 2.1)
- Figure 2.2 shows a photo of a gonioscopy
- This shows a complete angle closure glaucoma (Shaffer grade 0 or closed angle)
- Usually we also:
 - Check the intraocular pressure of these patients
 - Do gonioscopy
 - Check the optic nerve
- Findings:
- Elevated intraocular pressure.
- Management:
 - Depends on severity:
 - How high is the intraocular pressure?
 - What will be the conditions of the optic nerve or its function?
 - Conservative treatment:
 - Give topical medications or:
 - Systemic anti-glaucoma medications ex. acetazolamide or:
 - Mannitol used to decrease pressure in the eyes, as in glaucoma, and to lower increased intracranial pressure
 - Advanced glaucoma: laser procedures
