Released in May, 2014, the 840-page U.S. National Climate Assessment report was created by a team of 300 experts, led by a 60-person advisory committee. The report found that evidence of human-induced climate change is strong. Consistent with changes in climate trends, summers are getting hotter and extended periods of excessive heat last longer than in living human memory. Rain is heavier, and allergies are worse than before.

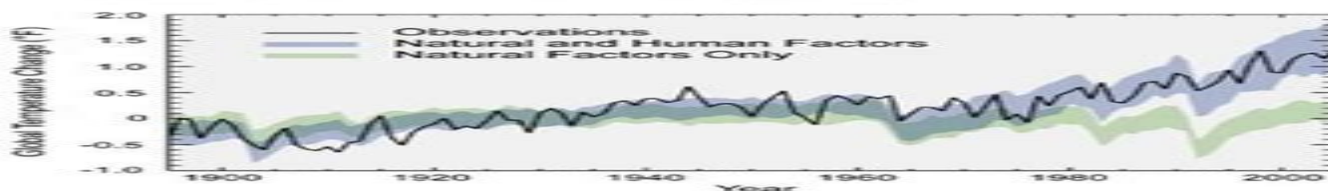
ALL SIGNS POINT TO WARMING



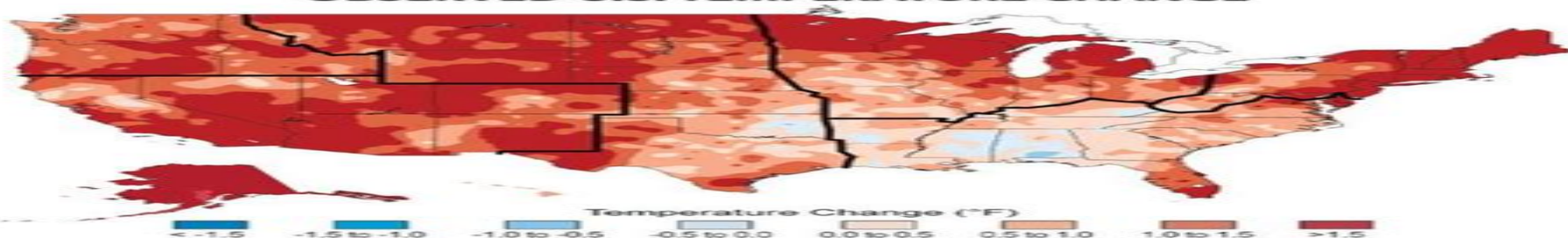
White arrows indicate increasing trends; black arrows indicate decreasing trends. All the indicators expected to increase in a warming world are found to be increasing. Indicators expected to decrease are in fact decreasing.

HUMAN VS. NATURAL INFLUENCES ON CLIMATE

The black line shows the actual observed global average temperature change. Only with the inclusion of human influences can models reproduce the observed temperature changes.



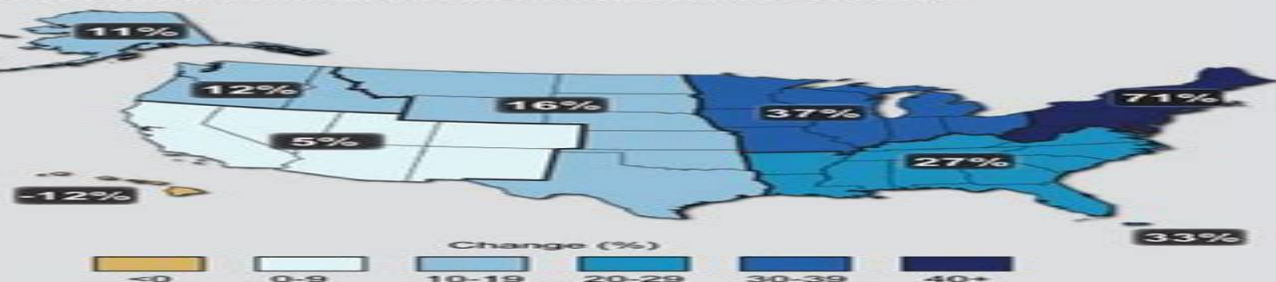
OBSERVED U.S. TEMPERATURE CHANGE

TREND TOWARD HEAVIER PRECIPITATION

Percent changes in the amount of precipitation falling in very heavy events (defined as the heaviest 1 percent of events) from 1958 to 2012 for each region. There is a clear national trend toward a greater amount of precipitation being concentrated in very heavy events.
