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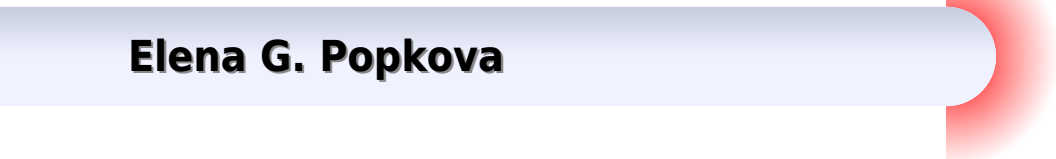

Treaties on the Domestic Level Christof Heyns,Frans Viljoen,2021-08-04 The six main United Nations human rights treaties enjoy almost universal ratification today Almost 80 per cent of the possible ratifications have been made and every Member State of the UN has ratified at least one of these treaties The nearly universal acceptance of the treaties on the formal level however does not automatically translate into the norms contained in these documents being made a reality in the lives of the billions of people living in these countries The treaty system is notoriously weak in terms of international enforcement and there is a general suspicion that it has had little impact at the domestic level Mechanisms to improve the international enforcement mechanisms of the six main treaties have been a topic of discussion and research for many years but the domestic impact of the treaties has never been investigated in a systematic and comprehensive manner This book constitutes the most ambitious attempt so far to establish the impact of the treaties at the domestic level The following treaties in 20 United Nations Member States are investigated the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination the Covenant on Economic Social and Cultural Rights the Covenant on Civil and Political Rights the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women the Convention Against Torture and the Convention on the Rights of the Child This book reflects the findings of 20 researchers based in the countries investigated under the leadership of Professors Christof Heyns and Frans Viljoen of the Centre for Human Rights University of Pretoria in a study done in co operation with the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights The influence of the treaties in each of the 20 countries is investigated in respect of its influence on the continuation legislation court cases policies and practices and the impact of the treaty system in civil society In an overview chapter by the study leaders based on a

comparison of the available data common trends and patterns are identified and recommendations about reforms on the national and international level are made This is a book that should be read by all those interested in the development of the international human rights system

The Admissibility of Human Rights Petitions Tom Zwart, 2022-06-08 Both global and regional human rights treaties have established international institutions offering recourse if a State party fails to comply with its obligations under the treaty Many of these institutions have jurisdiction to consider complaints brought by individuals claiming that a State party has violated the rights enumerated in the treaty However these same institutions appear no longer merely to confine themselves to considering individual petitions Due to the growing number of complaints they have become increasingly preoccupied with managing their workload The present volume focuses attention on two international institutions one regional the European Commission on Human Rights and one global the Human Rights Committee It thoroughly examines the admissibility conditions of both the Commission and the Court by means of their case law and discusses possible changes which might reduce this case load Chapter 2 discusses the procedural aspects of both systems in particular the division of labour and the various stages of the proceedings Chapters 3-9 explore the case law of both organs concerning admissibility conditions and such topics as competence *ratione personae* including standing the victim requirement and State responsibility competence *ratione temporis* competence *ratione materiae* inadmissibility *pendente lite* and the exhaustion of local remedies

The International Law of Human Rights and States of Exception Anna-Lena Svensson-McCarthy, 2021-09-27 This study demonstrates the extensive protection that international law provides to human rights even in the most serious of emergencies when they are particularly vulnerable Based on a meticulous analysis of preparatory works and practice under the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights as well as the American and European Conventions on Human Rights and with a special chapter on the International Labour Organisation's approach to international labour standards and emergencies this book shows that respect for the rule of law and the concept of a democratic society are controlling parameters in any valid limitation on the enjoyment of human rights It further shows that respect for human rights and the operation of institutions such as the Legislature and Judiciary are crucial to enabling societies to address and eventually remedy the root causes of emergency situations The study recommends possible directions for the development of case law and suggests some practical means to help ensure that international legal requirements are in fact respected in emergencies

indigenous peoples and their lands modern international law's human rights program has been modestly responsive to indigenous peoples' aspirations to survive as distinct communities in control of their own destinies. This book provides a theoretically grounded and practically oriented synthesis of the historical, contemporary and emerging international law related to indigenous peoples. It will be of great interest to scholars and lawyers in international law and human rights as well as to those interested in the dynamics of indigenous and ethnic identity.

Detention in Non-international Armed Conflict Lawrence Hill-Cawthorne, 2016. International law has long differentiated between international and non-international armed conflicts, traditionally regulating the former far more comprehensively than the latter. This is particularly stark in the case of detention, where the law of non-international armed conflict contains no rules on who may be detained, what processes must be provided to review their detention and when they must be released. Given that non-international armed conflicts are now the most common form of conflict, this is especially worrying and the consequences of this have been seen in the detention practices of states such as the US and UK in Iraq and Afghanistan. This book provides a comprehensive examination of the procedural rules that apply to detention in non-international armed conflict, with the focus on preventive security detention or internment. All relevant areas of international law, most notably international humanitarian law and international human rights law, are analysed in detail and the interaction between them explored. The book gives an original account of the relationship between the relevant rules of IHL and IHRL, which is firmly grounded in general international law scholarship, treating the issue as a matter of treaty interpretation. With that in mind and with reference to State practice in specific non-international armed conflicts, including those in Sri Lanka, Colombia, Nepal, Afghanistan and Iraq, it is demonstrated that the customary and treaty obligations of States under human rights law continue absent derogation to apply to detention in non-international armed conflicts. The practical operation of those rules is then explored in detail. The volume ends with a set of concrete proposals for developing the law in this area in a manner that builds upon rather than replaces the existing obligations of States and non-State armed groups.

National Human Rights Action Planning Azadeh Chalabi, 2018-07-18. This book deals with human rights action planning as a largely under-researched area from theoretical, doctrinal, empirical and practical perspectives and, as such, provides the most comprehensive studies of human rights planning to date. At the theoretical level, by advancing a novel general theory of human rights planning, it offers an alternative to the traditional state-centric model of planning. This new theory contains four sub-theories: contextual, substantive, procedural and analytical ones. At the doctrinal level, by conducting a textual analysis of core human rights conventions, it reveals the scope and nature of the states' obligation to adopt a plan of action for implementing human rights.
