,FORMAT(GETDATE(), 'D', 'en-US') as US_Spelled  
,FORMAT(GETDATE(), 'd', 'en-gb') as England  
,FORMAT(GETDATE(), 'D', 'en-gb') as Eng_Spelled
```

The locale of this query is primarily set to English, with specific variations for the United States ('en-US') and the United Kingdom ('en-gb').

'en-US': English used in the United States for both short and long-date formats.

'en-gb': English used in the United Kingdom for both short and long-date formats.

SQL Server CONVERT and FORMAT Examples

```
SELECT GETDATE() as Todays_Date  
,CONVERT(VARCHAR, GETDATE(), 0) as Number_Zero  
,CONVERT(VARCHAR, GETDATE(), 1) as Number_One  
,FORMAT(GETDATE(), 'yyyy-MM-dd') as YYYY_MM_DD  
,FORMAT(GETDATE(), 'dddd MMMM dd, yyyy') as Long_Date
```

Both CONVERT and FORMAT functions are employed for date formatting, with CONVERT allowing for a numeric style parameter and FORMAT allowing for a custom format string.
