Basic medical procedures, prescriptions, and fuel are being discontinued. According to experts, the financial crisis may be more to blame for the deaths in Sri Lanka than the coronavirus. There are frequent blackouts and violent street brawls. The lack of force and the inability to obtain safe drinking water has made it extremely difficult to organize crisis healthcare services. There has been an intrusion into the security net projects. The situation in Sri Lanka is much more complicated than just a money crisis. There is a charitable emergency here.
