According to Brooks, "The Underground Railroad had no track and no locomotives; it was, instead, a system set up by opponents of slavery in the antebellum United States to help slaves escape to free states, Canada, and other locations, around 75,000 slaves were freed." People took action regardless of the fact that if they got caught helping African-Americans escape to freedom, they could have been sent to jail or even killed.
