1. Section title

You can either add your research experience into your work experience section, into a dedicated research section, or in an additional information section. In this example, we created a dedicated research section.

2. Mention awards for your research

If the high quality of your work has been acknowledged by an award, early promotion, or similar outside recognition, include it!

3. Use 'research-focused' action verbs

Use action verbs like "Researched" or "Sourced" which clearly emphasize research skills. In some cases (like in this example), you can list publications in your bullet points itself.

4. Use numbers

If research is part of the job description, make sure you include at least one bullet point highlighting how you've used those skills in the past. Including metrics, like the number of articles or participants, contextualizes your accomplishments and helps them stand out.

5. Institution name

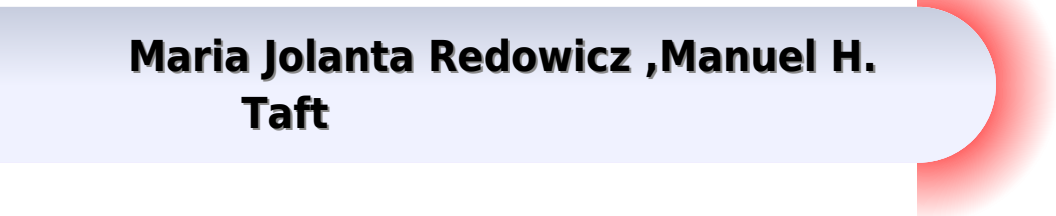
Typically, you should include the name of the company where you conducted research. You can omit this if you performed independent research, or if the research was not substantial and you want to keep it short.

6. Other parts of your resume

You can also include your research experience to your resume's summary, projects or "Additional Information" sections. Keep mention of your research short in these other sections.
