

Introduction to Content and Methods of Philosophy

I. What is Philosophy?

Before we begin our investigation into some classic problems of philosophy, it will be useful to say a few words about what the discipline of philosophy is and what the study of philosophy involves.

Philosophy = the love of wisdom (begins with curiosity)

From the Greek: *philo* = love

sophos = wisdom

Problem: This is not a very helpful definition.

What exactly is "wisdom"? How is wisdom different from knowledge?

Don't *all* the academic disciplines seek wisdom?

If so, how does defining philosophy as "the love of wisdom" mark philosophy off from other disciplines?

So, we might try to reformulate our definition of philosophy as follows:

Philosophy = the discipline which tries to improve our understanding of certain fundamental intellectual problems which **resist solution**.

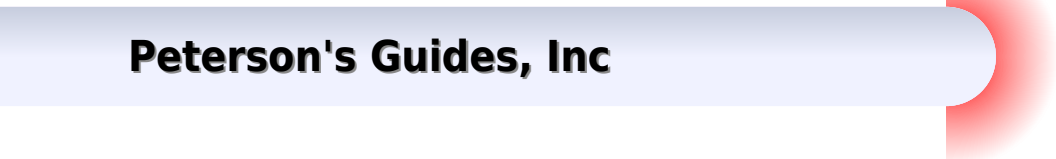
– Questions that didn't make progress and spin off into their own sciences
