At nine months babes are researching their environment.

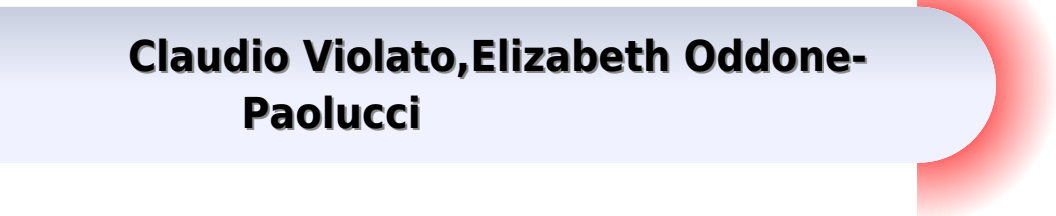
