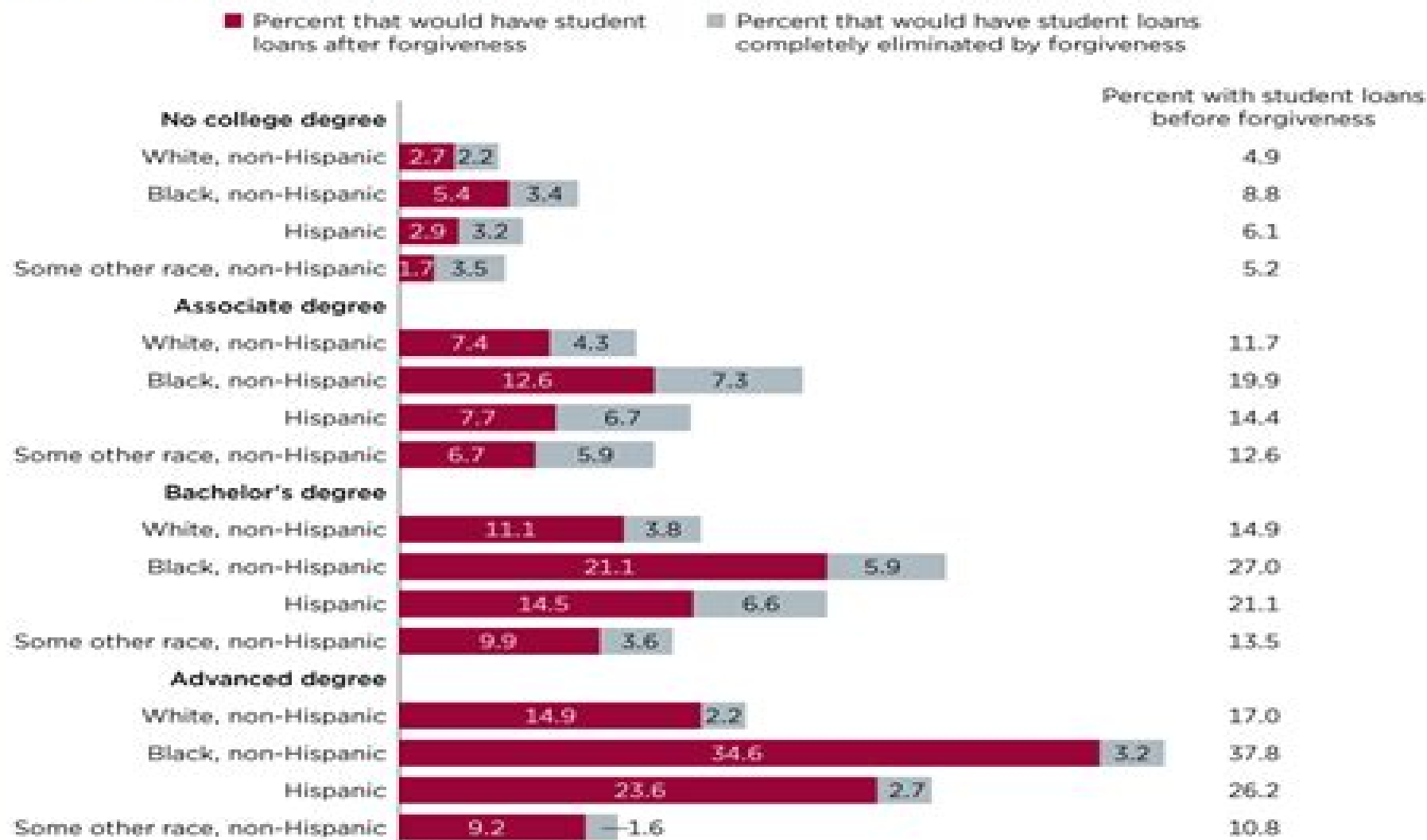


Share With Student Debt Before and After Proposed Debt Forgiveness by Race and Education: 2020
