In the narrative of Macbeth, by William Shakespeare, Macbeth is one of the chief characters. At the beginning of the drama Macbeth is really loyal and honest. By the terminal of the drama Macbeth is insane and has no compunction for the wickedness he commits against the male monarch.

Through the class of the book Macbeth transforms from an honest and baronial adult male to a selfish and hateful individual. His courage is evident to all and a captain coverage to the male monarch put it best when he said, I must describe he was a cannon overcharged with dual clefts (Act I, scene II) . Macbeth besides shows a great trade of trueness when he is greeted by the male monarch, as thane of Cawdor (Act I, scene IV) . The King is excited with joy and felicity for Macbeth and sends two knights to inform Macbeth of his new rubric thane of Cawdor.
