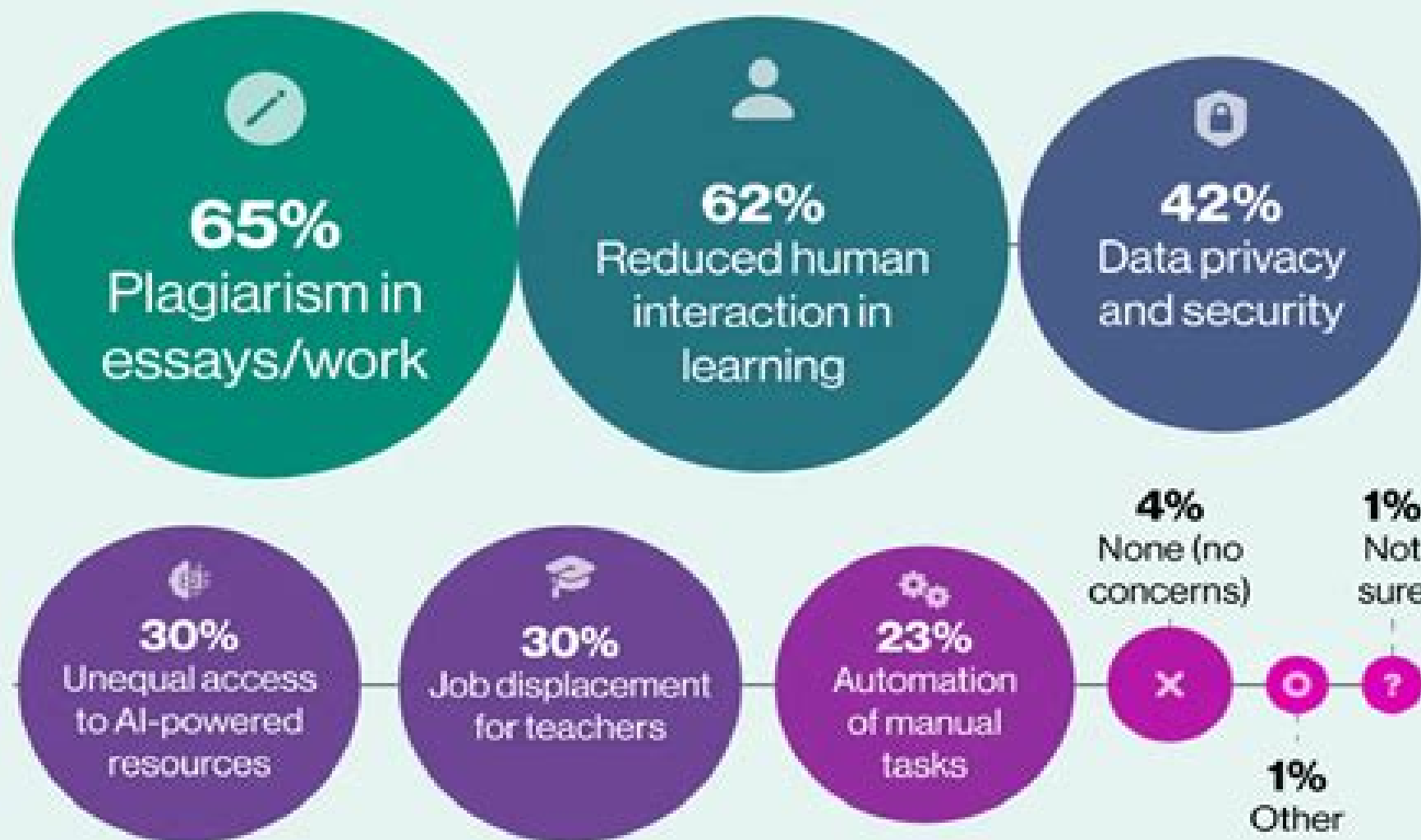

Grimm, 2019-04-10 This volume focuses on the evolution of public policy and the role of agenda setting with regard to policymaking in countries of the Global South The authors illustrate the emergence of public policy research as an academic discipline and highlight various aspects of history governance politics and economics as components of public policy theory development By offering a cross national perspective the papers contribute to a better understanding of when how and by whom a given policy agenda is designed which is essential to grasping how policy is implemented In turn the authors investigate how the development of public policy research has influenced policymaking in fields such as democratization migration corruption agriculture environment education and entrepreneurship and more specifically agenda setting in selected countries of the Global South

Low-fee Private Schooling Prachi Srivastava, 2013-05-13 Low fee private schooling represents a point of heated debate in the international policy context of Education for All and the Millennium Development Goals While on the one hand there is an increased push for free and universal access with assumed State responsibility reports on the mushrooming of private schools targeting socially and economically disadvantaged groups in a range of developing countries particularly across Africa and Asia have emerged over the last decade Low fee private schooling has thus become a provocative and illuminating area of research and policy interest on the impacts of privatisation and its different forms in developing countries This edited volume aims to add to the growing literature on low fee private schooling by presenting seven studies in five countries Ghana India Kenya Nigeria and Pakistan and is bookended by chapters analysing some of the evidence and debates on the topic thus far The book presents research findings from studies across three levels of analysis that have proven relevant in the study of low fee private schooling the household school and state Chapters address household schooling choice behaviours regarding low fee private and competing sectors the management operation and relative quality of low fee private schools and changes to the regulatory frameworks governing low fee private schools and the impact of low fee private schools on those frameworks The book does not seek to provide definitive answers since as an emerging and evolving area of study this would be premature Instead it aims to call attention to the need for further systematic research on low fee private schooling and to open up the debate by presenting studies that use a range of methods and owing to the context specificity of the issue draw different conclusions The hope is that these studies may serve as springboards to further research Finally the book does not aim to snuff out the political and vociferous debate surrounding low fee private schooling and private provision more broadly or to erase the complications that abound in conducting research in this area but to engage with them The hope is that as the 2015 target date for Education for All and Millennium Development Goals approaches this book may help us get closer to answering the question do low fee private schools aggravate equity or mitigate disadvantage

CURRICULUM REFORM IN PAKISTAN Amna Afreen, 2022-02-25 I have written this book in an effort to explore how the history of Pakistan has resulted in the critical problems weighing down its education system The book examines the questions Why and how has a small elite class come to rule Pakistan And how has their rule worsened the country's problems The focus will be to critically examine the elements of the Pakistani national curriculum and madrasas and their effects on Pakistani society The book represents the fusion of my experiences in Pakistan with extensive literature analysis interviews and textbook analysis This research began when I came to the United States in January 2015 through the SAR program I wanted to know the answers to profoundly unsettling questions How can a society be so intolerant that a scholar educated solely in Pakistan is disregarded and assassinated while many Western educated scholars with traditional insular thoughts are not only appreciated but flourishing I wanted to know why Pakistani elites have so much power and freedom while lower classes are profoundly oppressed Elites who barely pay taxes have been in power for generations while those that pay taxes suffer from sky high inflation The influential religious leaders mostly belong to the elite class while their followers are mostly lower class Ruling families and social classes mostly control appointed positions Do those in power not have a responsibility to speak on issues of social justice rather than limiting themselves in claiming that theirs is the only true form of Islam Why don't they work to end the disparity of quality education between classes in Pakistan Instead many elites run their own lucrative elite Islamic schools More importantly why do the ulama which literally means those who possess knowledge of Islam particularly of Islam maintain a tight hierarchical system in the madrasa Islamic seminary community that rarely allows poor intelligent students to attain leadership positions Why are the ulama silent in the face of ruthless murder of and discrimination against Pakistani minorities Book Review Pakistan Educational Reforms is a major study of education in Pakistan and its national and madrasa curriculum that fosters national and religious sectarian divisions intolerance and conflicts Dr Amna Afreen documents the political socio economic and religious causes limited government funding widespread poverty and illiteracy and the poor training and performance of teachers that have produced a failed educational system at urban and rural government and religious schools madrasa and offers a series of potential solutions and reforms John L Esposito University Professor and Founding Director of The Alwaleed Center for Muslim Christian Understanding Georgetown University Resources in Education ,1993 Education, Privatisation and Social Justice Ian Macpherson, Susan Robertson, Geoffrey Walford, 2014-05-12 The involvement of private actors in education is not new yet in the last decade critical issues have arisen that demand close scrutiny This volume explores emerging forms of the private through case studies from Africa South Asia and South East Asia and makes three related observations First what is new about these manifestations is their scale scope and penetration into almost all aspects of the education endeavour from the

administrative apparatus to policymaking and from formal provision in education settings to out of school activities such as private tutoring Second what is particularly controversial about these developments is how education itself is being recast as a sector it is increasingly being opened up to profit making and trade and to agenda setting by private commercial interests Third the learner is increasingly conceptualised as a consumer and education a consumer good The case studies therefore enable us to see more clearly how different forms of the private in education alter what is at stake for whom and with what outcomes and the consequences for individuals and societies In turn these raise the very important question about what they mean for our conceptualisations of education learning and teaching on the one hand and for education as a site and means for emancipation on the other These are profound social justice concerns and ones that make this volume distinctive This book sets out to address these hard but urgent questions and will be of interest to academics and students of education education researchers government personnel and policymakers
