Psychology is the scientific study of behavior and the mind as well as conscious experience

Systemic means to be performed according to a set of rules or conditions

Empirical means being capable of being verified or disapproved by observation or experiment

Types of research

- **Basic** is research seeking knowledge for the sake of knowledge like learning about space because you like space
- **Applied** is research trying to answer a specific question like learning about the pollution to battle climate change
- **Translational** is taking things you learn from basic research and applying them to a specific problem like learning about medicine because you want to then figure out a drug.

Early History:

- **Philosophers** like Plato were asking questions about the mind
- **Physiologists** like Ali ibn al-'Abbas al-Majusi detailed the anatomy of the brain
- **Mind-Body Problem** was a problem of how we can study the mind if it is unobservable
 - **Dualism**
 - Mind and the body are two separate entities that are made of two very fundamentally different forces so like physical and spiritual
 - **Rene Descartes** argued that the mind is inherently immaterial and therefore unknowable. He stated that our body is controlled by our mind exerting actions that moved through our bodies like tubes
 - **Monism**
 - Belief that the mind and body are one so going against **Dualism**
 - **Thomas Hobbes** stated that mental events were due to physical events
 - Important Idea for psychology that showed the mind can be studied by measuring physical processes.
- **British Empiricism**
 - Believed that all ideas and knowledge were gained empirically – through the senses
 - Observation is more valid than reason as reason can have potential for error
 - **John Locke**
 - Philosophy should focus on the capabilities and extent of the human mind. Basically, what can our minds do and how well can they do it
- **Wilhelm Wundt**
 - First psychology labs came from his students
 - Father of modern psychology
 - Used scientific techniques to study the mind

Structuralism:

- Break it down into elementary components to see what pieces allowed it to do stuff
- **Wilhelm Wundt** and **Edward Titchener** studied the mind in terms of the basic elements and used **introspection**
 - "Look within" to describe one's experiences
 - Focused on sensations which they considered the basic elements of consciousness. Not conducting experiments

Functionalism:

- Look at the function or purpose of the entire big picture
- **William James** and **James Rowland Angell** focused on investigating the function or purpose of consciousness like "what does the mind do"
 - Influenced by **Darwin's theory of evolution**
 - Stressed important of adaptation in helping organisms survive and reproduce
