Cognitive Behavioral Approaches

- Behavioral perspective- Operant and classical conditioning (can be caused by: trauma, abuse, bad parenting)
- Cognitive perspective- How people think about and perceive themselves, and their relations with others
- Biology- Can predispose someone to having a psychological disorder.
