FIRST AID GUIDE

How to deal with accidents and emergencies

- Keep calm and look for any dangers to yourself or the injured person.
- Find out what happened, and how.
- How many casualties are there?
- Is there anyone around who can help you?
- Do you need an ambulance?

ADULT RESUSCITATION

Check if the adult is responsive by "Shake, Scream, Lean your head". If there is no response, shout for help. Tilt the head back by tilting the neck. Open the mouth by tilting the head back. If breathing normally, call an ambulance and get medical advice. If not breathing normally, call an ambulance and get medical advice.

If the person is not breathing normally, give 30 chest compressions before giving 2 mouth-to-mouth breaths. Continue until the person is breathing or an ambulance arrives.

CHOKING

- Ask "Can you cough?" If they can cough, encourage them to cough. If they can't, perform the Heimlich maneuver.
- If they cannot cough, give up to five back blows between the shoulder blades with the heel of your hand (Fig. 1).
- If this object is not dislodged, perform the Heimlich maneuver. This is a technique that allows the wind to push the object out of the mouth (Fig. 2).
- Continue the cycle of five back blows and five abdominal thrusts until the object is dislodged.
- If the person is unconscious, lay them on their back and perform the Heimlich maneuver. If the object is not dislodged, call an ambulance.

Anyone who has been choked for choking is in the red cross for the first aid for choking.
