A. **Main Idea:** English colonists, ideas about the rule and shape of government influenced the growth of the colonies, the laws that they created, and the system of government that later today.

1. **Colonial**, **Christianity**, culture, and ideas influenced how political governments are important contributions to the founding principles and development of the United States.

2. The principle that a government's power is derived absolutely from the people. **Magna Carta**, which the English people have regarded as a guarantee of **limited**, **government**.

3. The English **Bill of Rights**, and other documents that established and confirmed principles, documents applied to them and gave them the same rights as people living in Britain.

4. The English system of **law**, especially as organized by the British Parliament, was widely followed in the colonies.

5. British Parliament, which distinguished itself by the people, was a familiar example of **representative** government, but the colonies.

6. Thomas Hobbes developed the **Social Contract**, theory which suggested that people give up their individual sovereignty to the government in exchange for the government's maintenance of law and order.

7. John Locke believed that people have **natural**, **rights**, as human beings and a government that failed to protect them has no right to be legitimate.

8. John Locke believed that **men**, **women**, **children**, believed that people rights and responsibilities depend on people as a community, especially as a social contract to protect their rights while creating law and government.

9. Charles-Louis de Montesquieu suggested **separation**, the powers of government.
