- Is your dialogue formatted correctly? EXAMPLE: "You look awful today," he said.
- Is each paragraph indented?
- Is your narrative multiple paragraphs?
- Is your narrative AT LEAST 2 pages, double spaced?
- Is your narrative formatted in the following way:

- 12 point font
