There were also significant correlations between both the economic status of the household and the perceived effect of OTC medications with caregiver s report of when they would give OTC medications. No significant relationships were found between trust in doctors barriers to seeking care and gender of the child and either the choice of giving OTC medication or calling the doctor.
