The Polyphonic World of Cervantes and Dostoevsky Slav N. Gratchev, 2017-12-06 This book is the first scholarly attempt to examine *Don Quixote* from the angle of dialogism and polyphony. To begin with although Mikhail Bakhtin considered Dostoevsky the creator of a polyphonic novel we believe that the first elements of polyphony can be observed in Cervantes' *Don Quixote*.
