(1.2.89-94)	Connection: Personal Reaction While the idea that Benvolio presents to Romeo about a way to overcome his rejection is important to the plot, what particularly strikes me about this passage is the language. To anyone examining this, what stands out the most is the rhyming couplet at the end of the passage. Not only is it pleasing to the ear but it also serves as a punctuation point on Benvolio's advice to seek out another romantic interest. Additionally, the metaphor relating to swans and crows further emphasizes Benvolio's insistence that Romeo get over Rosaline. While the white and black imagery, and its association with goodness, does not sit well with my modern sensibilities, I can appreciate Shakespeare's transformation from a traditionally beautiful bird to one that is traditionally maligned much like someone's feelings may change as they overcome a heartbreak.

She knows Juliet well to the hour she was born. She wants the nurse to help her be a mother that was why she wanted her to come back.

(1.3.97-104)</i>	She is trying to convince Juliet to marry Paris for his nobel status. When I read this I understood why they wanted her to marry Paris because he seems like a good man and he has high status which will help them in the feud against the montagues. But he's also DOUBLE Juliet's age which could be problematic if not for the time period. Lady capulet compared to Sir capulet is trying to get her to marry quickly while he wants the best for her and, not to force marriage on her.
